Coroner's case: On April 10, 2018 at 3:32 PM, Officers were dispatched to the 700 block of Turquoise Dr. for a subject who was currently being administered CPR. Officers were advised a 72 year old male was doing yard work and collapsed. The subject was pronounced deceased by a RHFDP Paramedic. The Coroner's Office was contacted and released the body to the family.

Felony Vandalism/Felony Probation Violation: On April 10, 2018 at 10:31 p.m. Hercules Officers were dispatched to the 400 block of Falcon Way for a report of a family disturbance. The reporting party stated his 29 year old brother was being violent and throwing things around. The subject was determined to be on active Formal Felony Probation with a search clause. The reporting party stated his brother shattered the home's rear sliding glass door and had possibly fled outside toward the backyard. Officers searched the house, and yard, and found the subject hiding inside an outdoor shed. The subject displayed objective symptoms of alcohol intoxication. One of the conditions of the subject's Probation includes not to possess or consume any alcohol. The subject's right hand had a superficial cut. His hand was examined, and treated, by AMR prior to him being transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.
