Non-injury collision: On May 21, 2018 at 10:19 AM, Officers were dispatched to the intersection of San Pablo Ave @ Sycamore Ave. for a non-injury collision. Officers met with the involved parties. Neither party was injured. Both parties agreed on the events preceding the collision.

Non-injury collision: On May 21, 2018 at 6:36 PM, Officers were dispatched to the 1200 block of Hercules Ave. for a traffic collision with injuries. Officers observed a vehicle, collided with two parked cars, and overturned in the middle of Hercules Ave. The driver stated his vision was obscured by the low setting sun. He veered to the north, ultimately colliding with two parked vehicles. The driver, and both of his passengers, were able to exit the overturned vehicle under their own power. No parties suffered any injuries.

Grand Theft On May 21, 2018 at approximately 6:39PM a HPD Officer was dispatched to Starbucks (842 Willow Ave) for a theft of a laptop. The reporting party stated an African American adult male; wearing a black hooded sweatshirt, black pants, and red shoes; stole his Apple Macbook. The victim followed the suspect, as he ran out the store, and saw the suspect was picked up a gold 2000 Toyota Camry.

Possession of a Controlled Substance: On May 21, 2018 at approximately 8:25PM, HPD Officers were dispatched to a residence, in the 1000 block of Avocet, to conduct a welfare check. Officers contacted the subject in question and determined she was okay. Officer observed a gray 2004 Lexus RX300, occupied by a 26 year old male, in front of the residence. Officers saw a small brown bag on the dashboard. The

occupant admitted the bag belonged to him. He said the bag contained "methamphetamine". The male was arrested for Possession of a Controlled Substance and later cited and released.

Probation Violation: During the above mentioned call, a second 26 year old male was determined to be on probation with a search clause. The subject was determined to be in violation of conditions of his probation. He was arrested and taken to the Martinez Detention Facility.
