Auto Burglary: On June 5, 2018 at 9:19 AM, Officers were dispatched to 3600 San Pablo Ave. for an auto burglary which just occurred. The reporting party stated her vehicle was burglarized during a five minute time span while she was in the bank. The unknown suspect/s broke the passenger side front window and only took loose change from the center console.

Warrant Arrest: On June 5, 2018 at 11:54 AM, Officers were dispatched to the 2000 block of Lupine Rd. for a family disturbance. Officers learned an adult male, from the address, had an outstanding warrant. Officers contacted the subject and placed under arrest for the warrant and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Prisoner transport: On June 5, 2018 an officer went to Yolo County correctional center and picked up an adult female, from San Pablo, for an active misdemeanor warrant from our agency. The subject was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Possession of a Loaded/Concealed Firearm: On June 5th 2018 at approximately 10:39PM a HPD Officer checked on a suspicious vehicle in the 3900 block of San Pablo Ave. The white 2004 Toyota Solara was occupied by a 42 year old male, of San Francisco; a 40 year old male, of Antioch; and a 16 year old male juvenile. The 42 year old male was determined to be on probation, out of Solano County, with a search clause. As the male juvenile was being removed from the vehicle, the Officer noticed a bulge in his front right pant pocket and a pat search was

conducted. A loaded pistol was located. A search of the interior of the vehicle turned up a make shift window punch. All three were placed under arrest and transported to HPD. The two adults were later released pending further investigation. The juvenile, who was the 42 year old's son, was transported to Juvenile Hall for booking.
