Residential Burglary: On July 6, 2018 at 10:49am, officers responded to the 400 block of Sparrow regarding a residential alarm. During an interior search of the home, evidence of a burglary was discovered. The suspect(s) shattered the rear slider to gain entry into the home. All the bedrooms in the house were ransacked and a firearm was missing. On 7/9/18, at 4:17 p.m., the victim reported locating his firearm hidden in a boot in his garage. The victim also noticed it appeared the firearm had been discharged into the mattress of his bed during the burglary. Evidence was collected to be submitted to the lab for processing.

Identity Theft: On July 6, 2018, a resident in the 100 block of Grenadine reported someone in Texas opened an account using her husband's personal information.

Residential Burglary: On July 6, 2018 at 5:57pm, officers responded to the 200 block of Obsidian Way to investigate a residential burglary. The victim stated he left the residence at about 10:00 a.m. today. He returned home at 5:55 p.m. and saw shattered glass from the rear slider on the family room floor. Officers checked the residence for suspect(s) with negative results. All the bedrooms in the house were ransacked. Entry was made through the shattered rear slider. The take at this time is unknown.

Warrant Arrest: On July 7, 2018 at 11:25 a.m., an officer conducted a traffic stop on Village Parkway at Hercules Ave. The driver, a 27 year old male from Fairfield, was arrested for an outstanding warrant related to a

previous Hercules PD case. The subject was transported to County Jail and his vehicle was towed.

Possession of a Controlled Substance: On July 7, 2018 at 3:20 p.m., an officer conducted a traffic stop in the 800 block of Willow Avenue. The driver, a 33 year old male from Rodeo, was arrested for possession of several Hydrocodone pills not prescribed to him.

Auto Burglary: On July 7, 2018 at 10:42 a.m., an auto burglary occurred at 3500 Franklin Canyon Rd. Video surveillance showed the suspect park next to the victim's vehicle. The unidentified suspect got out his vehicle and shattered the driver's side window of the victim's vehicle. The suspect stole the victim's garage door opener. No other property was taken. 1085)

Commercial Burglary: On July 8, 2018, at 9:26 a.m., a Rite Aid employee reported a theft of cosmetics had just occurred. The suspect was described as a heavyset black or Hispanic male in his twenties, wearing a black and gray striped sweatshirt, black pants, and black shoes. He stole about \$200 worth of cosmetics and got in silver Lexus ES 350. The suspect vehicle fled eastbound on Sycamore Avenue. At 10:31 a.m., officers responded to the Burger King at 836 Willow Avenue for an unresponsive women in the driver's seat of the same Lexus. A 31 year old female was contacted and stated she fell asleep. She was placed under arrest for investigation of the burglary. An area check for the male met with negative results. The Lexus was processed for evidence and towed. The female denied being involved in the theft and was later released pending additional investigation. The suspect was later identified as a 22 year old male from Rodeo. The case was submitted to the suspect's probation officer.

Warrant Arrest On July 9, 2019 at approximately 1:24 a.m. an officer conducted a pedestrian stop in the 700 block of Willow Ave. A 34 year old male from Rodeo was contacted and determined to have five outstanding warrants out for his arrest. He was transported to County Jail.

Possession of a Stolen Vehicle: On July 9, 2018, at 3:21 p.m., an officer conducted a traffic stop on a gray 2018 Alfa Romeo Stelvio TI Sport on Pebble Bay at Victoria Crescent West. The vehicle had been reported stolen to Berkeley P. D. on February 13, 2018. The driver, a 22 year old male from San Pablo was arrested. He said he was a former employee of the dealership the vehicle was stolen from and kept the vehicle out of spite for being mistreated as an employee. A dealership employee responded to take possession of the vehicle and the subject was transported to County Jail.

Vandalism: On July 9, 2018, at 6:03 p.m., a citizen reported the window of his 2004 Toyota was smashed by unknown means while it was parked in the 100 block of Civic Drive. Occurred between: July 8, 2018, at 8:30 p.m. and time of call.

Warrant Arrest: On July 10, 2018, at 10:22 a.m., an officer conducted a traffic stop and arrested the driver, a 28 year old female from Vallejo, for an outstanding warrant. She was transported to County Jail.

Grand Theft: On July 10, 2018, at 12:31 p.m., a Wells Fargo Investigator called to report a possible embezzlement case. Purportedly, the caregiver of a mentally disabled victim who lives in Antioch, has been cashing checks in excess of \$85,000 at the Hercules branch in the victim's name. This investigation is ongoing.

Residential Burglary: On July 10, 2018, at 2:34 p.m., a citizen from the 1000 block of Cottage Lane reported her house had been burglarized sometime between 1:30 p.m. to 2:30 p.m. The suspect forced the front door open and stole an undetermined amount of cash from a dresser drawer in the master bedroom. Forensic evidence was collected to be submitted to the lab.

Vandalism: On July 10, 2018, at 6:21 p.m., a citizen from the 100 block of Paradise Drive reported noticing a bb hole in her front window pane. Occurred sometime within the last week.
