Auto Burglary: On July 16, 2018, between 9:20 a.m. to 10:20 a.m., a vehicle burglary occurred in the 800 block of Willow Avenue. The suspect smashed a rear window and stole a khaki/green colored suitcase containing clothes belonging to the victim.

Warrant Arrest: On July 16, 2018, at 10:33 a.m., an officer conducted a traffic stop at 3900 San Pablo Avenue. A 33yr old passenger was arrested on two outstanding warrants.

Warrant Arrest: On July 16th 2018 at approximately 8:06PM HPD Officers were dispatched to a suspicious circumstance in the 2000 block of Lupine Rd. Officers contacted a 56 year old male, of San Pablo. The subject was taken into custody on two non-citable warrants and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Domestic Violence: On July 16th 2018 at approximately 10:38PM HPD Officers were dispatched to a residence in the 300 block of Porthole for a domestic disturbance. Officers contacted a 28 year old female, who advised her husband had kicked her out of the house after she attacked him following an argument. The 38 year old husband was contacted and had small abrasions on his cheek and forehead. He advised his wife scratched him after several days of arguing. The male declined to press charges and medical attention. The female was taken into custody and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility. An Emergency Protective Order was offered, to the husband, but not declined.
