**Commercial Burglary / Pursuit:** On July 31, 2018, at 8:25 a.m., a grab and run theft of power tools occurred in the block of Sycamore Avenue (Home Depot). An employee reported two known thieves, a Hispanic male and an African American male in their 20's were inside the store. Police arrived and saw the two males hurrying into a waiting gray 2000's model BMW, with paper plates, in front of the store (unknown suspect driver). A pursuit ensued and lasted about 2.5 miles before officers lost sight of the BMW as it continued to flee at speeds in excess of 100 mph on eastbound I-80.

**Warrant Arrest:** On July 31, 2018, at 8:49 a.m., officers responded to the 1500 block of Sycamore, Rite Aid, for a report of a theft of alcohol that just occurred. When officers arrived, the suspect had returned the alcohol to the employee, who did not want to press charges. However the 40 year old male, of San Francisco, had a warrant out of San Francisco. He was transported to Martinez Detention Facility.

**Lost Plate:** On July 31, 2018, at 12:45 p.m., a citizen from the 2000 block of Central Street reported the license plate from his 2014 Harley Davidson motorcycle, fell off somewhere while he was riding it. The plate number was entered in to the Stolen Vehicle System.

**Attempted Residential Burglary:** On July 31, 2018, at 2:51 p.m., a resident, from the 1000 block of Chelsea, reported someone attempted to enter her condominium. The resident heard a knock at the door, but failed to acknowledge the suspect. The suspect then removed a window screen and peered through the blinds. Upon seeing the resident the suspect fled the area in a silver or gray Honda sedan.

**Suspicious Circumstance:** On August 1<sup>st</sup> 2018 at approximately 12:46AM HPD Officers were dispatched to the 300 block of Sparrow Dr for possible mail theft in progress. A silver Toyota Corolla, with a Hispanic female driver, was associated with an African American male subject wearing a black hoody. The male was seen going through mail boxes, up and down Sparrow Dr. Officers conducted an area check but were unable to locate the vehicle or subject.
