Hit and Run: On August 20, 2018, at 07:43am, a road rage incident resulted in a hit and run. A silver 2017 Nissan collided with a black 2016 Kia, while traveling southbound on San Pablo Avenue at Hercules Avenue. After stopping, the driver of the Nissan walked up to the Kia, proceeded to yell, and then punched the car before fleeing the scene toward Pinole. The Nissan is registered to an address in Antioch. The driver of the Kia positively identified the owner of the Nissan as the suspect

Suspicious Circumstance: On August 20, 2018, at 2:00pm, officers were dispatched to the 100 block of Alder Court for a report of a Black male adult seen at the front door with his hoodie cinched tight around his face. The subject identified himself as "Michael" and asked for "Rico." When the homeowner told him he had the wrong house, the subject ran to a black Chrysler 300 with tinted windows parked in front of the residence. Within minutes of receiving this call, a resident in the 200 block of Pepperwood reported a similar incident. An area check for the Chrysler met with negative results.
