Fraud: On September 12, 2018, at 12:54 p.m., officers responded to Chase Bank regarding a female attempting to use a fake identification to get bank account information on another customer's account. A Chase Bank employee said the subject, a 22 year old female from San Pablo, attempted to use a fake driver's license and a fake credit card issued to someone else in order to gain that person's account information. The victim was contacted and said she did not give anyone permission to use her personal information and did not know the detained subject. The subject admitted to knowingly using a fake ID and fake credit card in order to obtain the victim's bank account information to get money. The subject said she got the fake ID and credit card from someone else. She was transported to County Jail.

Auto Burglary: On September 12, 2018, at 5:21 p.m., a citizen reported he parked his black 2007 Dodge 1500 in the Lucky's parking lot at 5:10 p.m. When he returned to the vehicle at 5:15 p.m., he saw the rear passenger window was shattered. Stolen from the vehicle was a backpack which contained a laptop, an iPhone, a wallet and credit cards. The victim said an unidentified witness told him he saw a black female and a black male breaking into his vehicle and leaving the area in a white minivan in an unknown direction.
