Supplement to Domestic Violence Case From September 15, 2108: On September 17, 2018, at approximately 8:31 am, a 47 year old male suspect came to HPD in regards to a Domestic Battery, with corporal injury, case taken on September 15. The subject was determined to be the primary aggressor in the case, and was placed under arrest for felony domestic battery. The subject was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Identity Theft: On September 17, 2018, at approximately 11:06 am, a Hercules resident came to HPD. She wanted to report in December of 2014 someone rented a U-Haul truck using her personal information, and she just learned of it when she attempted to rent a U-Haul truck on September 16, 2018.

Collision/Battery: On September 17, 2018, at approximately 11:42 am, HPD Officers were dispatched to the area of Hercules Avenue and San Pablo Avenue for a physical altercation. An Officer located the two involved vehicles at San Pablo Avenue and Sycamore Avenue. A 42 year old female was driving her 2008 Honda Accord, north bound on San Pablo Avenue. She got upset over an accident with a 41 year old female, driving a 2017 Ford Explorer, northbound on San Pablo Avenue near Hercules Avenue. The front of the Honda struck the rear of the Ford. The driver of the Ford got out of her car and walked up to the driver's window of the Honda. The driver of the Honda grabbed the driver of the Ford by her hair, and hit her in the face and head several times. The driver of the Ford had some bumps on her head, and a laceration to her lip. The driver of the

Honda was placed under arrest, for Battery, and transported back to HPD. The Driver of the Honda was cited and released

Injury Collision: On September 17, 2018, at approximately 4:55 pm, HPD Officers were dispatched to a collision in the McDonalds Parking lot. Officers located the 80 year old female driver, from Rodeo, sitting on the curb with lacerations to her arms, and hands. The female was driving her 2002 Honda east on Sycamore and making a right turn into the north entrance to a parking lot. The subject apparently stepped on the gas, and accelerated, as she was approaching her turn. The subject's vehicle struck a 2004. The female had injuries to her arms, and hands, and was treated by Paramedics at the scene, and released.
