Warrant/Shoplifting: On September 26, 2018 2:25pm, HPD officer were dispatched to Home Depot for a completed theft. The 26 year old male suspect of El Sobrante, was apprehended a short distance away in one of the local businesses. Some of the stolen merchandise was recovered in the subject's possession. The reporting party positively identified the suspect in an in-field show up. The subject also had a misdemeanor, warrant out of San Pablo. The subject arrested and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Warrant Arrest On September 26th 2018 at approximately 9:10PM HPD Officers were dispatched to the 200 block of Palermo Ct for three suspicious vehicles. Officers contacted a 40 year old male Hercules resident. He was determined to have a citable warrant. The subject was released at the scene with a new court date.

Domestic Violence On September 27th 2018 at approximately 12:49AM HPD Officers were dispatched to the 100 block of Paradise Dr for a domestic disturbance. The 44 year old male, reporting party, stated his 36 year old female fiancé slapped him twice on the face. The male did not have any visible injuries and he declined to press charges. During the investigation the male was sitting on a bench outside his residence. He became verbally combative with Officers. He made incoherent statements and displayed the objective symptoms of alcohol intoxication. The subject was determined to be unable to care for him and was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Warrant Arrest: On September 27, 2018 at 10:11am an Officer checked on a suspicious vehicle in the 3900 block of San Pablo Ave. A 31 year old female occupant, of Vallejo, was found to have a citable misdemeanor warrant out of Napa. The female was cited, with a new court date, and released at the scene.

Found Property: On September 27, 2018 an employee of Bio- Rad found a credit card on John Muir Parkway and contacted HPD. Attempts to contact the owner were unsuccessful. The card taken entered into evidence.
