Warrant Arrest: On November 29, 2018 at approximately 10:29pm, Officers stopped a 1997 Nissan Altima for driving without any headlights. The 45 year old male driver, out of Oakland, was found to have two active warrants. The subject was given a new court dates, and cite released at the scene.

Residential Burglary /Stolen Vehicle: On November 30, 2018 at approximately 5:08am, Officers were dispatched to the 100 block of Stone Pine Ct for a report of a stolen vehicle. The reporting parties stated, approximately 5-10 minutes prior to calling, they heard a noise come from their garage. The reporting party went to check and found his gold 2009 Honda Accord missing from inside the garage. The keys were inside the vehicle at the time of the theft. The suspect made entry into the garage from an unlocked side garage door.

Wanted Person Pick-Up: On November 30, 2018 an officer picked up an adult male, from Solano County Jail for a \$250,000 warrant originating from this agency. He was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Warrant Arrest On November 30th 2018 at approximately 9:10PM a HPD Officer conducted a traffic stop, on a gold 1999 Toyota Camry. A 28 year old female, of Oakley, was taken into custody on a non-citable \$50,000 warrant held by Antioch PD. She was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility for booking.

Warrant Arrest: On December 1, 2018 at 11:37am, an Officer stopped a 51 year old female, on Starling at Pheasant, for a vehicle code violation. The subject was found to have a citable warrant out of Marin County. She was given a new court date, cited, and released at the scene.

Attempted Residential Burglary: On December 1, 2018 the resident, from the 1700 block of Redwood reported an attempted burglary of his residence. The incident occurred sometime after 6:00pm on November 26, 2018. An unknown suspect(s) attempted to pry open the victim's front door.

Recovered Stolen Vehicle: On December 2, 2018, at approximately 5:18 pm, a San Pablo resident called HPD to say she located her stolen 2015, Ford Fusion, in the back of Chelsea near the 1300 building. The vehicle was taken on December 1, 2018, from the victim's residence in San Pablo. The Ford was returned to the victim.

Package Theft: On December 2, 2018 at 7:37 PM a package was taken from the porch in the 2000 block of Tsushima. A surveillance video captured an unknown race male wearing a black hoodie and black bandana taking the package from the porch.

Concealed dirk/dagger, possession of paraphernalia, CCC probation violation: On December 3, 2018 at 12:05 AM an Officer conducted a pedestrian stop on an adult male, at 76 gas station at 828 Willow Ave. The subject was on active, searchable probation. During a probation search, of his person, the Officer located a "neck knife" hanging from a lanyard around his neck. The knife was completely concealed and is a fixed blade dagger. The subject also was in possession of a glass bulbous pipe commonly used to smoke narcotics... The subject was arrested and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Auto Burglary: On December 3, 2018, at approximately 7:46 am, an Officer was dispatched to Glasgow for an auto burglary. The Officer located a 2015 Chevrolet full size Van, parked in the guest parking, with a broken front passenger window. Sometime between December 2, at 7:00 pm, and the time of the call, an unknown suspect broke the window to the van, and took a briefcase. The briefcase contained personal documents and a business checkbook. The victim owned another van, of the same type, which was parked directly next to the van with the broken window. Someone had ransacked that unlocked van as well. Later, on the same day, a suspect attempted to cash two of the victim's stolen checks. One check was attempted in Pittsburg, and the other was in Concord. A 31 year old male was arrested, in Concord, when he attempted to cash the second stolen check

Prisoner Transport: On December 3, 2018 a Parking Enforcement Officer went to San Clara County Jail to pick up a 49 year old female for an arrest warrant held by HPD. She was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility and booked.

Theft by False Pretense: On December 3, 2018, at approximately 12:33 pm, an Officer responded to the 1100 block of Cottage Lane for the report of a fraud. The 47 year old victim received a virus on her computer, and attempted to get the virus fixed by purchasing iTunes Gift Cards and giving the information to a person on the phone. The problem was never fixed.

Miscellaneous Information/ Possible Fraud: On December 3, 2018, at approximately 1:40 pm, an Officer responded to the 400 block of Grenadine for the report of a possible fraud. The 51 year old victim sent money to a travel agency to purchase tickets to Nigeria. The victim said several friends also used the same travel agency to get their tickets to Nigeria. She, and all of her friends, showed up at the airport and were told there is no tickets for them. The flight is not scheduled until December 25, 2018; however, she can't reach anyone at the travel agency anymore. A case was taken to document the incident.

Suspended Driver/Possession of Methamphetamine, Probation Violation: On December 3, 2019 at 10:06 PM, an Officer conducted a traffic stop on a 2000 Buick La Sabre, for an equipment violation, on Palm Avenue just east of Sycamore Avenue. The vehicle was occupied by three occupants. The 36 year old male driver had a suspended driver's license and was found to be on searchable probation. The 36 year old male rear passenger was also found to be on searchable probation out of Contra Costa County. During the probation search, of the passenger, the Officer located a substance, suspected to be a narcotic, on his person. The passenger was arrested and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility... The driver was cited and released. The third occupant had a valid driver's license and took possession of the vehicle.
