**Auto Burglary:** On December 12, 2018, at approximately 7:53 am, an Officer was dispatched to Hercules High School for an auto burglary which occurred at Lucky Supermarket. The victim said between 7:35 and 7:42 an unknown suspect broke the front passenger window of a 2016 Hyundai Sonata and took a cell phone from the front passenger seat.

**Solo Vehicle Collision:** On December 12, 2018, at approximately 9:16 am HPD Officers were dispatched to the area of Refugio Valley Park for a vehicle collision with the vehicle in the water. The vehicle was located at the end of Refugio Rd, north of Sycamore Avenue, in the creek. The driver, a 25 year old female, who was 8 months pregnant, was still in the vehicle but not injured. Rodeo Hercules Fire responded, and she was removed from the vehicle and transported to a Hospital for safety precautions for the baby.

**Missing Person:** On December 12, 2018, at approximately 3:45 pm, a subject came to HPD to report his 58 year old father missing. Officers went to father's house, in the 200 block of Newbury, several times the evening of December 11, 2018. There had been multiple motion alarm activations, for several different areas of the house. The son met with officers, at the residence, and gave permission for Officers to force entry to check the welfare of his father who lived alone. The father was not located in the residence, and the door was secured by public Works. On December 12<sup>th</sup> the son still was not able to locate his father and reported him missing. Later, on the 12<sup>th</sup> the father contacted the Police Department

and stated he was now home. Officers checked on him and notified the son.

**BobCop:** On December 10, 2018, at approximately 4:21 pm, a resident from the 200 block of O'Neil reported someone fraudulently used his stolen Citibank Card.

**Runaway Juvenile:** On December 12<sup>th</sup> 2018 at approximately 9:08PM a HPD Officer was dispatched to a residence in the 200 block Scotts Valley for a runaway juvenile. The reporting party stated her 14 year old foster son, was last seen when she dropped him off school in El Sobrante. He was to return home at 8:00PM but failed to do so. The subject is an African American male; 5-8; 140 lbs; and was last seen wearing a black dew drag and maroon colored jumpsuit. He was entered into the Missing and Unidentified Persons Systems; and a Trak flyer was distributed.

**Warrant Arrest:** On December 13<sup>th</sup> 2018 at approximately 2:15AM a HPD Officer conducted a traffic stop, on a black 203 Nissan Altima, in the 800 block of Willow Ave. The 25 year old male driver, of Rodeo, was taken into custody on a \$30,000 warrant held by Vallejo PD. He was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

**Auto Burglary:** On December 13<sup>th</sup> 2018, at approximately 6:17AM, HPD Officers were dispatched to 3700 San Pablo Ave (Starbucks) for a window smash vehicle burglary that occurred five minutes prior. The victim's white Toyota Prius was broken into and a black backpack was taken. The suspect was described as a younger African American male, who was seen getting into a charcoal/grey Infiniti SUV.

**Warrant/ Possession of a Controlled Substance/ Possession of Paraphernalia:** On December 13<sup>th</sup> 2018 at 9:02 AM an Officer contacted an adult male in the 3900 block of San Pablo Avenue. The subject had a non-citable warrant out of Contra Costa. He was arrested and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility. During Transport the subject advised he had narcotics in his sock. The Officer located the substance, believed to be narcotics,, and a glass bulbous pipe, commonly used to smoke narcotics.

**Petty Theft:** On December 13<sup>th</sup> 2018 at 10:14 AM, an Officer was dispatched to the 1500 block of Sycamore for a theft of her handicapped placard. The reporting party said the placard was left in their vehicle between December 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup>. When they returned to the vehicle they found the placard to be missing.

**Resist Peace Officer:** On December 13<sup>th</sup> 2018 at 12:37 PM, an Officer attempted to contact an adult male for walking in the roadway towards traffic. He repeatedly disobeyed commands. Eventually the subject was detained; arrested for resisting arrest; and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

**Found Property:** On December 13<sup>th</sup> 2018 at 1:55 PM, keys and a cellphone were located in the parking lot of 111 Civic Drive. The items were collected for safe keeping.

**Hit and Run:** On December 13<sup>th</sup> 2018 at 4:00 PM, Officers were dispatched to Victoria Crescent West and Paradise Drive for a hit and run. Officer's contacted the victim and she advised a gold sedan side swiped her vehicle and fled into the Victoria Green Apartments. Officers located the suspect vehicle, but were unable to locate the Suspect.

**Recovered Stolen Vehicle:** On December 13<sup>th</sup> 2018 at 3:50PM, Civic Center Tow advised they had towed a Blue 2016 Hyundai Sonata from the 900 block of Dover. The car was found to have been reported stolen out of Concord. An Officer went to Civic Center and recovered the vehicle.

**Residential Burglary** On December 13<sup>th</sup> 2018 at approximately 8:27PM a HPD Officer was dispatched to the 200 block of Violet Rd for a residential burglary that occurred sometime within the last two days. The reporting party stated unknown suspect(s) entered his garage and took several items.

**Warrant Arrest** On December 13<sup>th</sup> 2018 at approximately 8:49PM a HPD Officer conducted a pedestrian stop in the 1600 block of Sycamore Ave. The 35 year old male, of Vallejo, was taken into custody on a no-citable warrant held by Vallejo PD. A 37 year old female associate also had a no-cite warrant, out of Napa County. Both subjects were transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

**Solo Vehicle Collision** On December 13<sup>th</sup> 2018 at approximately 10:20PM HPD Officers were dispatched to the area of Refugio Valley Rd and Redwood Rd for a vehicle into a tree. Officers located a 2007 Mercedes. The vehicle had gone off the roadway and collided into a tree. The 54 female driver, of Hercules, did not have any visible injuries. She was evaluated by paramedics but declined to be transported. The tree did not appear to sustain any damage.

**Theft (Unlocked vehicle):** On December 14, 2018 at 2:17pm. a Hercules resident submitted an online report for a theft that occurred sometime

between 4:00pm and 5:00pm

December 13, 2018. The vehicle was parked in the 200 block of Meadowlark at the time of the theft. The loss was a purse.

**Vehicle Collision** On December 14<sup>th</sup> 2018 at approximately 8:13PM HPD Officers were dispatched to the area of San Pablo Ave and Victoria Crescent East for a vehicle collision. A 2012 Dodge Ram collided into the driver's side of a 2000 Ford Explorer. The driver of the Ford suffered a laceration to his finger and was transported to a hospital for further evaluation. The driver of the Dodge was not injured.

**Domestic Violence and Vandalism** On December 14<sup>th</sup> 2018 at approximately 8:31PM HPD Officers were dispatched to the 3900 block of San Pablo Ave for a physical fight involving three subjects. Officers contacted the adult female victim; a 37 year old male witness; and the 49 year old suspect. The victim and suspect were conducting a custody exchange when an argument ensued. The victim's six week old puppy got out of her vehicle and when the victim knelt down to grab it the suspect threw her on the ground. The witness restrained the suspect until police arrived. The victim suffered facial lacerations and a possible broken nose. The suspect reportedly punched and damaged the victim's vehicle during the altercation. The suspect was placed under arrested and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility. An Emergency Protective Order was issued.

**Possession. of a Controlled Substance/and Paraphernalia** On December 14<sup>th</sup> 2018 at approximately 11:01PM a HPD Officer checked on an occupied black 1997 Dodge pickup truck in the 800 block of Willow Ave. A 47 year old male, of Sacramento, stated he was on searchable probation out of Placer County. An Officer saw a glass pipe, commonly used to smoke narcotics, on the dashboard of the vehicle. A probation was conducted and a substance, suspected a narcotic, was located inside the vehicle. The subject was placed under arrest and later cite/released at the scene.

**Theft:** On December 15, 2018 at 9:48am, an officer was dispatched to 1860 John Muir for a report of a theft. The reporting party said, sometime after 3:00pm yesterday, an unknown suspect stole the catalytic converter from his 2003 Ford F350.

**Theft:** On December 15, 2018, at 4:34pm an officer was dispatched to the 100 block of Stanley regarding a theft. The victim left her wallet in the glovebox of her vehicle last night. Today she went to multiple location in

San Francisco. When they returned to Hercules, she noticed her wallet was missing. One of her credit cards were used in San Francisco today.

**Driving Under the influence:** On December 15, 2018 at 6:39 pm, Hercules Officers were dispatched to the 100 block of Tidewater for the report of a collision that occurred within the last five minutes and the suspect vehicle was still on scene. Officers contacted the adult male driver, of Hercules, next to his vehicle. The subject exhibited symptoms of extreme intoxication, and was unable to perform The Standard Field Sobriety Test. He was arrested based off of his objective signs of Driving Under the Influence. He was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

**Warrant Arrest:** On December 15, 2018 at 9:27 pm, Hercules Officers were dispatched to N Front Street, and Tsushima Street, regarding a possible missing person. The 25 year old female reporting party, out of Richmond, was found to have a misdemeanor citable warrant out of San Jose. The possible missing was located with other friends. The reporting party was cite released for her warrant.

**Outside Assist:** On December 15, 2018, at 11:29 pm, Hercules Officers were dispatched to the area of Refugio Valley Road, and Southwind, for a driver who was following a subject who hit and ran him on the freeway. Officers contacted the 44 year old driver and determined him to be intoxicated. CHP responded to take the Driving While Intoxicated and the Hit and Run.

**Burglary/Auto Theft:** On December 17, 2018, at approximately 9:26 am, an Officer was dispatched to the 400 block of North Wildwood for the report of a vehicle theft. Sometime between December 16, 2018 at approximately 12:00 pm, and December 17, 2018 at 9:00 am an unknown suspect/s made entry into the detached garage and stole a black. 2002, Subaru Forester from inside the garage. The keys were left inside the vehicle. There is another set of keys missing, for a second vehicle, which was in the garage.

**Missing/Located Person:** On December 17, 2018, at approximately 11:24 am, an Officer handled a lobby detail for a missing 14 year old. The subject walked away from school in El Sobrante, and was not able to be located. The Missing Juvenile was later located and removed from Missing and Unidentified Persons Systems.

**Warrant Arrest:** On December 18, 2018. at 1:09 AM an officer checked a Gray Dodge Charger at Sycamore Avenue and Redwood Road. The vehicle was found to be occupied by three subjects who had been smoking marijuana. One of the occupants, a 19 year old male, an active Felony

Warrant out of Contra Costa County. The subject was arrested and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.
