**Wanted Person Pick-Up:** On December 20, 2018 at 10:07am, The Parking Enforcement Officer responded to the Napa County Jail and picked up an adult male, on our warrant, and transported him to the Martinez Detention Facility.

**Found Property:** On December 20, 2018 at 2:12pm an officer took possession of a purse found today in Refugio Valley Park. The purse was logged into evidence as found property.

**Residential Burglary:** On December 20, 2018 at 2:25pm, officers were dispatched to a residential burglary alarm in the 100 block of Dartford. Officers saw evidence of a burglary and checked the residence for suspects. None were located. The suspects gained entry by shattering the rear glass slider.

**Residential Burglary:** While at the above incident, dispatched notified officers of another burglary in the, 1200 block of Canterbury, with the homeowner on scene. The homeowner told officers he received a call from ADT at 2:13pm regarding an alarm activation. He called his daughter to check the house. His Daughter told him the outside of the house "looks okay" so he did not have PD dispatched. Entry was made by shattering a rear glass sliders.

**Vandalism:** On December 20<sup>th</sup> 2018 at approximately 7:54PM a HPD Officer was dispatched to the 3700 block of San Pablo Ave for a vehicle burglary report. The reporting party stated the rear passenger window, of

his 2007 Chrysler Pacifica, was shattered. He advised no entry was made into his vehicle and nothing was taken.

**Residential Burglary:** On December 21<sup>st</sup> 2018 at approximately 3:00AM HPD Officers were dispatched to the 800 block of Orion for a suspicious circumstance. The reporting party stated she heard her garage door open and went downstairs to investigate. When she opened the interior garage door, she saw an African American male; in his 20s; wearing a gray and white shirt, with a black beanie; standing inside her garage. She closed the door and called 911. Officers conducted an area check but could not locate the subject.

**Residential Burglary** On December 21<sup>st</sup> 2018 at approximately 7:29PM HPD Officers were dispatched to the 1200 block of Willow Ave for a residential burglary that occurred within the last two hours. Entry was made by shattering the rear sliding glass door

**Warrant Arrest:** On December 21<sup>st</sup> 2018 at approximately 11:03PM a HPD Officer conducted a traffic stop on a white, 1994 Honda Civic, in the 800 block of Willow Ave. A 20 year old male passenger, of Rodeo, was taken into custody on a non-citable warrant. He was transported to Martinez Detention Facility.

**Shoplifting:** On December 22, 2018 at 10:43 a.m. Hercules Officers were dispatched to Rite Aid, 1560 Sycamore Ave. for a theft that just occurred. Dispatch advised four African American females, in their 30's, just stole items and fled in a large Gray pick-up truck, last seen on W/B Sycamore Ave. towards San Pablo Ave. Officers did an area check, but didn't locate the suspect vehicle. An Officer contacted the reporting party and determined the suspect vehicle to actually be a Champagne Chevy Suburban, with no license plates attached. The four suspects used large reusable bags to steal multiple bottles of alcohol. The four suspects made no attempt to pay for the alcohol and fled outside to the Suburban. The Suburban was parked backed into a parking stall near the front entrance.

**Warrant Arrest:** On December 22, 2018 at 5:32 p.m. An Officer checked on an occupied suspicious vehicle parked in the Park & Ride, 800 Willow Ave. The Gold '00 Nissan Maxima had blankets and cardboard in the windows preventing a view into the vehicle. The Maxima had expired registration over 6 months (February 2018). However, there was also a 2019 year tab affixed to the rear license plate. A 46 year old male, Transient, was found in the rear of the Maxima. He had an outstanding Misdemeanor No Cite Warrant out of Napa County. The subject was arrested and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

**Warrant Arrest** On December 22<sup>nd</sup> 2018 at approximately 10:04PM a HPD Officer conducted a traffic stop, on gray 1998 Saturn sedan. The 20 year old male driver, of Rodeo, was taken into custody on two warrants. One was for felony, out of Oakland PD, and the second was out of Berkeley PD. He was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

**Battery:** On December 23, 2018 at 1:16 p.m. Hercules Officers were dispatched to the 100 block of Paradise Dr. for a report of a Battery that just occurred. The female reporting party stated a male just hit her and fled the area in an older White pick-up truck. Officers located the 27 year old female victim and observed she had noticeable redness/swelling to both ears. The victim told Officers she was punched, in both ears, by a 53 year old male acquaintance. The suspect was giving the victim a ride from Rodeo. She asked him to stop the truck so she could get out on San Pablo Ave. at Victoria Crescent West. The suspect initially refused to let her out. The victim managed to get out of the truck, but was punched in the head twice (both ears) by the suspect. The suspect was last seen driving away towards Rodeo. Rodeo-Hercules Fire and AMR responded to the scene and transported the victim to a hospital. An Officer did an area check and located a White '04 Dodge Dakota parked in Rodeo. The suspect was inside the truck. He was arrested and transported to Hercules PD. The subject was later cited and released.

**Warrant Arrest:** On December 23, 2018 at 11:05 PM an Officer contacted a suspicious vehicle at 1352 Willow Avenue (Bart Lot). The vehicle was a white 2016 Chrysler 200 occupied by three subjects. The 21 year old male driver had an active non citable misdemeanor out of our agency. The subject was arrested and transported to The Martinez Detention Facility.

**Corners Case:** On December 24, 2018, at 11:39 a.m. an officer was dispatched to the 100 block of Glenwood for a report of a possible deceased male. A friend came by to check on the 67 year old male discovered he appeared to be deceased. Rodeo-Hercules Fire responded and called the time of death at 11:49 a.m. He was last seen on December 18, 2108, at noon when the friend dropped him off at home. There was no evidence of foul play. The Coroner's Office responded to pick up the body.

**Coroner's Case:** On December 24, 2018, at 12:55 p.m. an officer responded to the 100 block of Kensington Circle for a person not breathing. The 87 year old male was pronounced dead at 1 p.m. by Rodeo-Hercules Fire. He was last seen, by family members, on December

23, 2018, at 8 p.m. The subject suffered from medical issues. The Coroner's Office was contacted and they released the body to the family.

**Accident:** On December 25, 2018, at 5:55pm, HPD units were dispatched to the area of 1400 block Willow Ave. for a tree into a pole. Officers discovered a black 2006 Mustang struck a tree and was found resting against a pole. There was no driver on scene. The vehicle registration returned to a female subject in Rodeo. Officers responded to that residence and the subject's mother said they would take care of the vehicle later.

**MISSING PERSON:** On December 26, 2018 at 6:04 AM, resident from the 1500 block of Chelsea called to report his wife missing. They had a verbal argument on December 25, 2018 at 7:41 PM. She had left the residence to decompress. The subject did not return home, and the husband felt it was out of the norm, and reported her missing.
