**Mail Theft:** On December 26, 2018, at 11:23 a.m., an Officer was dispatched to the 100 block of Paradise for a report of mail theft from a cluster of mailboxes. The Temporary Office Assistant observed, on surveillance recording, a Caucasian adult female stealing mail from the cluster of mailboxes on December 25, 2018 between 5:08 a.m. and 5:19 a.m.

**Unauthorized Use of a Credit Card Account:** On December 26, 2018, at 12:21 p.m. an Officer was dispatched to the 100 block of Paradise to meet with the reporting party. An Unknown suspect acquired his Macy's credit card account information and made on line purchases on his credit card.
