Identity Theft: On January 8, 2019, at approximately 8:12 am, an Officer was dispatched to HPD Lobby for an identity theft. A resident from 100 block of Raleigh Ct discovered three unauthorized accounts opened in her name sometime between May of 2018, and January of 2019.

Auto Burglary: On January 8, 2019, at approximately 12:39 pm, an Officer was dispatched to Burger King located at 836 Willow Avenue for the report of an auto burglary. The Officer determined, at approximately 12:32 pm, a Caucasian male adult; thin build; driving a newer model white Honda CRV unknown plate; arrived in the lot and was seen walking up to the front passenger window of the victims large cargo van. The front passenger window was broken, and a purse was taken from the front passenger seat.

Lost Property: On January 8, 2019, at approximately 3:04 pm, an Officer handled a lobby detail for lost property. Sometime between January 6, 2019, at 10:00 pm, and January 7, 2019 at 12:00 pm, the victim lost his Canadian Driver's somewhere in Hercules.

Possession of Illegal Weapon: On January 9, 2019, at 12:07 AM, an Officer contacted a suspicious subject, in his silver 2007 BMW 530i, in the Lucky's parking lot, 1560 Sycamore Avenue. The 46 year old male had Nunchakus in his possession readily available to be used as a weapon. The officer also found to have drug paraphernalia used to ingest narcotics; and an imitation Glock BB gun in his glove box, which was taken for safe keeping. The subject was arrested for possession of a dangerous weapon, and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Theft: On January 9, 2019, at approximately 9:14 am, an Officer was dispatched to the 100 block of Beryl Court for the report of a theft from an unlocked vehicle.

Auto Burglary: On January 9, 2019, at approximately 10:20 am, an Officer was dispatched to the 100 block of Thrush Court for an auto burglary. Sometime between January 8, 2019, at 11:00 pm, and January 9, 2019, at 6:00 am, an unknown suspect broke into a locked Toyota SUV and stole several items.

Property for Destruction: On January 9, 2019, at approximately 12:38 pm, an Officer was dispatched to HPD Lobby for a resident who wanted to turn in a firearm for destruction. The firearm turned out to be an older model long Daisy BB gun with a scope on it. The BB gun was taken for destruction.

A resident from the 100 block of Onyx was contacted by someone saying they were from Apple and her computer had been hacked. The victim provided the numbers for gift cards, in the amount of several thousand dollars, to the suspect. An attempt was made to contact the suspect and he was not able to be contacted.

Domestic Battery: On January 9, 2019, at approximately 5:03 pm, an Officer handled a lobby detail for a late reported Domestic Battery. On Friday, January 4, 2019, a resident from Peak Court got into an argument with the father of her child. The 30 year old suspect reportedly grabbed the victim by the arm, and pulled her until she was able to break free.
