Identity Theft (BobCop): On January 2, 2019, at approximately 10:33 pm, a resident from the 100 block of Starling Way submitted an online report for an identity theft. On January 1, 2019, the victim checked his credit report and noticed there was a Verizon account, opened in Omaha Nebraska, which he did not open or authorize. The account has been sent to collections.

Occupied Stolen Vehicle/Warrant X3/Shoplifting: On January 15, 2019, at approximately 3:19 pm, HPD Officers were dispatched to Home Depot for a subject being belligerent with store employees. Officers were advised a theft just occurred, and the suspects were leaving in a green colored Hyundai SUV. An Officer arrived and stopped a Green Hyundai, with paper plates, near the main entrance/exit area for Home Depot. There were four occupants in the vehicle. The occupants were a 44 year old male, from Pittsburg (Driver); a 25 year old female, from Pittsburg; an 18 year old male, from Pinole; and a 17 year old female, from Concord. The 44 year old male had three outstanding warrants. One warrant from Pleasant Hill, for vehicle theft and identity theft; one warrant from Pittsburg; and one warrant from Concord. The Hyundai was determined to be a stolen vehicle taken from Clayton earlier in the day. The older male and female were positively identified as the two subjects who stole merchandise from Home Depot. The merchandise was located in the Hyundai. The two older suspects were arrested. The two younger subjects were released at the scene. The female suspect was issued a citation, for Shoplifting, and released from HPD. The male was charged with Possession of a Stolen

Vehicle, Shoplifting, and the warrants. He was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Possession of a BB gun on School Grounds: On January 15, 2019, at approximately 3:04 pm, a School Resource Officer (SRO) was called to a classroom, on the High School campus, for a disruptive student. The 15 year old male student, was removed from the classroom and eventually sent home. Later a teacher informed the SRO the students backpack was left behind. A BB gun was located, in the students backpack, by the SRO. The student was suspended, pending further action.

**Occupied Stolen Vehicle Recovery/Possession of Stolen Property/
Possession of Burglary Tools:** January 16, 2019, at 3:28 AM, an Officer was conducting a security check at 3600 San Pablo Avenue. The Officer observed two vehicles parked along the fire lane in front of Chase Bank. The Officer contacted a 25 year old male, and 27 year old male, standing between a tan 2001 Hyundai Santa Fe, and an orange 2000 Dodge Durango Pickup with paper plates. A records check, of the vehicles, showed the Dodge was stolen out of Richmond on December 26, 2018. The 27 year old was interviewed and released from custody. The 25 year old male was arrested, and was found to be on Felony Probation, for possession of a stolen vehicle, out of Santa Rosa. The suspect was later transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.
