**Possession of Controlled Substance/Drug Paraphernalia/Probation**

**Violation:** On February 11, 2019, at approximately 11:24 am, an Officer stopped a white, Ford Fusion at Shell Gas Station, 3900 San Pablo Avenue, for an equipment violation. The 30 year old male driver, from San Pablo, was on active probation in Contra Costa County with a search clause. The Officer located a substance, believed to be a narcotic; and 2 glass pipes, commonly used to smoke narcotics, in the vehicle. The subject was arrested and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility. The Ford was towed and the license plates, on the vehicle, were taken to be returned to DMV because they did not belong on the vehicle.

**Auto Burglary:** On February 11, 2019, at approximately 12:32 pm, an Officer was dispatched to the 100 block of Paradise Drive for a vandalism to a vehicle. The Officer determined, sometime between February 10, 2019 at 9:00 pm, and February 11, 2019, at 11:00 am, an unknown suspect broke the front and rear passenger windows. The vehicle was a 2007 Toyota Camry which was parked in front of 1000 Pebble Bay. The suspect took a gray Nike ; some miscellaneous clothes, from the rear of the car; and a wallet containing credit cards, a driver's license, cash.

**Warrant Arrest:** on February 11, 2019, at 7:42 pm, an officer stopped a 44 year old male, of, Vallejo, at 4000 San Pablo Avenue, for multiple vehicle code violations. The subject had an outstanding "No cite warrant out of Napa County. He was taken into custody for the warrant and transported to Martinez Detention Facility.
