Miscellaneous Investigation: on February 12, 2019, at 7:01 pm, officer's responded to the 100 block of Robin Court for a report of citizens physically fighting in the street. One of the participants was said to be armed with a gun. The 37 year old male, who purportedly possessed the gun, was said to have fled the scene. The vehicle was described as a silver or gray four door sedan occupied by another, unknown, subject. Officers did a protective sweep. Involved parties included: 24 year old female, (who lives at the address); and a 25 year old male, of Vallejo (the female's current boyfriend). The investigation indicated there was an argument between The 37 year old male, and the 25 year old male, when the 37 year old showed up to drop off his child. One of the subjects thought they saw the 37 year old holding "A black object" in his hand" which might have been a gun. The investigation suggests no gun was present during the incident. A case was taken for documentation purposes.

Out of State Warrant: During the above incident, the 25 year old male, of Vallejo was found to have an outstanding extraditable warrant out of Sparks P. D., (Washoe County, NV) for multiple felony charges. The warrant was confirmed and the subject arrested and transported to Martinez Detention Facility.

Stolen Vehicle (Recovered): On February 12, 2019, at 7:08 pm, a citizen from the 2000 block of Pheasant Drive reported her 15 year old son took her vehicle, a brown 2003 Buick Century, without permission. She located the vehicle on the shoulder of the Hercules off ramp, from eastbound I-80.

She didn't wish to press charges, but wanted to make a report after noticing fresh damage to the front bumper.

Identity Theft: On February 12, 2019, at 9:30 pm, a citizen from the 300 block of Violet Road called to report her 16 year old daughter, has been making unauthorized purchases, with her debit card. Officers counselled the juvenile.
