Auto Burglaries: On February 13, 2019 at 7:11am an officer was dispatched to Earnest St at Bayfront for two auto burglaries. The first reporting party said, sometime after 6:00pm yesterday, an unknown suspect shattered the rear window of the 2014 Toyota Venza and rummaged through his vehicle. The second victim reported she parked her BMW at 7:00pm last night. She was notified by HPD of the burglary. Her vehicle was also rummaged through. Unknown take at this time for both victims.

Auto Burglary: On February 13, 2019 at 7:13am an officer was dispatched to the 100 block of Dunham for an auto burglary. The reporting party said, sometime after 7:00pm last night, an unknown suspect shattered the rear passenger window on her 2017 BMW and rummaged through it. No take at this time

Identity Theft: On February 13, 2019 at 9:14am an officer was dispatched to HPD for a lobby detail. The Hercules resident reported a collection account was on his credit report that he had no knowledge of. The account was for an unpaid dental bill.

Lost/Stolen Plate: On February 13, 2019 at 9:42am, a resident from Tran Ct reported the front license plate of his 1997 Toyota was missing. The plate was entered into Stolen Vehicle System.

Auto Burglary: On February 13, 2019 at 10:05am an officer was contacted at the Hercules Middle High School, regarding an auto burglary.

The reporting party said his 2004 Ford was burglarized sometime after 8:00am this morning. The unknown suspect shattered the front passenger window and stole a laptop.

Vandalisms: On February 13, 2019 at 10:07am an officer was dispatched to Woodfield at Williams for a report of two vehicles with shattered windows. Both victims lived in the 100 block of Cardoza. The vehicles were a 2016 Toyota and a 2013 Nissan. The incidents occurred sometime after 6:00pm last night. No evidence that the suspect entered the vehicles.

Passing Counterfeit Bills: On February 13, 2019 at 10:51am an officer was dispatched to the 3700 block of San Pablo Ave, regarding two fake \$20 bills. The bills were passed yesterday, at 5:20pm, at Extreme Pizza. An African American adult male, with short dreadlocks, entered the business and ordered a soft drink and paid with a fake \$20 bill. He then asked the cashier to make change for another fake \$20, which she did. Both bills had "REPLICA" typed (10 font) in the upper left and bottom right on the front of the bills.

Auto Burglary: On February 13, 2019 at 11:32am, an officer responded to the 100 block of Paradise for a report of an auto burglary that occurred at about 5:50am this morning. The reporting party parked his 2004 VW, last night, on the corner of Pebble Bay and Victoria Crescent West. This morning he came out to his vehicle and saw an African American male, wearing a white t-shirt leaning into his vehicle through a shattered driver's side window. When the suspect notice the reporting party approaching, he rushed to get into the passenger side seat of a late model blue Dodge Caravan. The reporting party said this was the same vehicle he saw leaving the area about a month ago when he suspected the suspects were trying to steal a motorcycle.

Domestic Assault: On February 13, 2019 at 11:49am, HPD was notified that Richmond PD was contacting a Domestic Violence victim at the Planned Parenthood Office in Richmond. RPD said the suspect was not on scene. The victim related she, and the 27 year old MALE suspect, got into a verbal argument in the parking lot of the Hercules Library. The argument turned physical and the suspect backhanded her on her left check and repeatedly slapped the left rear area of her head approximately 5 times as they drove thru Pinole and into Richmond. While HPD officers were in route, the suspect returned to Planned Parenthood where he was detained by RPD until Hercules officers arrived. After the investigation the male subject was arrested and transported to County Jail. The on-call judge was contacted and an Emergency Protective order was granted.

Public Intoxication: On February 13, 2019 at 12:34pm, officers were dispatched to the 100 block of Finch Court for an anonymous report of a male who was in front of the residence. An Officer contacted a 38 year old male, who was extremely intoxicated. He was standing near a residence in shorts/t-shirt and no shoes. The subject was determined to be unable to care for himself e. He was arrested and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Auto Burglary: On February 13, 2019 at 2:13pm, an officer was dispatched to Bayfront at Promenade for a report of an Auto burglary. At 2:13pm, a passerby saw the two front windows, of a 2017 Toyota, shattered. AT 4:34pm the victim called and reported his vehicle had been burglarized. The last saw his vehicle in tact at 7:00pm last night. The vehicle was rummaged through but the take is unknown at this time.
