Warrant Arrest: On February 26, 2019, at approximately 9:28 am, an Officer contacted 28 year old male, from Richmond, in front of 76 Gas Station on Willow Avenue. The subject had three misdemeanor warrants, and one felony warrant, for his arrest. He was arrested for the warrants and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility

Identity Theft: On February 26, 2019, at approximately 2:38 pm, an Officer handled a lobby detail regarding an identity theft. The Hercules resident received a call from Bloomingdales, in early February of 2019, stating her credit account was overdue. The subject disregarded the call because she knew she had not used the card. She just learned there was a significant amount, in overdue charges, on her Bloomingdales account which occurred in Palo Alto, and she also learned two more credit accounts were open in her name without her permission.

Lost License Plates: On February 26, 2019, at approximately 3:36 pm, an Officer handled a lobby detail for lost license plates. Sometime between November of 2018, and the time of call the reporting party lost his license plates to his 2016 Mercedes somewhere in his residence. The plates were entered into the system.

Unauthorized Use of Debit Card: On February 26, 2019, at approximately 4:44 pm, an Officer handled a lobby detail for a lost credit card which was fraudulently used. The Hercules resident lost his credit card a Lucky yesterday, and determined today there were fraudulent charges on the card.

Assault with Deadly Weapon: On February 26, 2019, at approximately 5:01 pm, HPD Officer were dispatched to the 1800 block of Redwood Road for a female bleeding. Officers determined a 26 year old female was riding, in the car, with her husband and three step children. The victim and her 23 year old step-son (suspect), got into a verbal argument. The suspect stopped the car and got out of the car. The suspect and victim continued to yell at each other. The suspect threw a metal container at the victim and caused a moderate laceration to her head. The suspect was placed under arrest for assault with a deadly weapon, and victim was transported to a hospital. The suspect was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Overdose: On February 26, 2019, at approximately 5:06 pm, HPD Officers were dispatched to the 100 block of Scotts Valley for the report of a male who was barely breathing. Officers arrived, and determined the 75 year old male was still breathing, and had taken several pills He was transported to a hospital.

Outside Assist: On February 26, 2019, at 8:09 pm, Hercules Officers responded to Bill's Liquor Store, 2350 San Pablo Avenue, to assist Pinole Officers by attempting to locate a suspect who robbed the clerk at knife point.

Prisoner Pick-up: On February 27, 2019, at 12:15 am, an Officer drove to Solano County Jail to pick up 34 year old male, of Vacaville. The subject was being held on a warrant issued by Contra Costa County Superior Court regarding a Hercules case. He was transported to Martinez Detention Facility.

Vehicle Collision (complaint of pain): On February 27, 2019, at 6:10 am, an officer located a vehicle versus vehicle collision on San Pablo Avenue at John Muir Parkway. A 2007 Toyota collided into a 2013 Honda, while trying complete a left turn from (southbound) San Pablo Avenue onto SR-4. The driver of the Honda complained of pain and was transported to county hospital in Martinez.
