Cold Hit &Run/Counter Report: On February 27, 2019 at 11:30am, a citizen came to HPD and reported he was the victim of a hit and run collision on February 22, 2019. The collision occurred in the 1300 block of Willow Ave. The unknown vehicle rear-ended subject's vehicle causing minor damage.

Vandalism: On February 27, 2019 at 12:54pm, an officer, at Hercules Middle High School, requested a case number for vandalism. A tenth grade male student ripped one of the school's telephones from the wall during an argument with the Principal.

Warrant Arrest: On February 27, 2019 at 2:51pm, officers was dispatched to 1560 Sycamore (Rite Aid) for a possible theft in progress. The caller stated there were two African American females filling bags with alcohol. As officers arrived the two female adults walked out of the store with the store manager following them. The store manager was unable to confirm a theft. The 18 year old female, of Vallejo, had a no-cite warrant. The warrant is out of Alameda County for theft and fraud. The arrestee was associated with a rented 2019 Nissan. During an inventory search of the vehicle, pursuant to impounding, suspected stolen property was located inside the vehicle. The officer will follow up on the case tomorrow to try to determine where the property was stolen from. The second 22 year old female was released pending further investigation.

Domestic Assault: On February 27, 2019 at 3:00pm, an officer was dispatched to the 200 block of Catalina Dr. for a 911 disconnect. It was

later determined a domestic violence incident occurred between 27 year old male and 27 year old female. The investigation determined the male slammed the female's head against a window sill, approximately 3 times, and hit her in the face with his right hand while holding a cell phone. The couple's 3 year old child was present during the incident. An Emergency Protective Order was granted. Children and Family Services was notified. The male was arrested and transported to County Jail.

Miscellaneous: On February 28th 2019 at approximately 2:30AM a HPD Officer observed two vehicles engaging in illegal sideshow activities in the 2800 block of Franklin Canyon Rd. As the Officer activated the patrol vehicle's overhead emergency lights, both vehicles (one black and one silver SUV) fled the area via W/B Hwy4 at a high rate of speed. No pursuit was initiated due to road conditions. An area check was conducted but the vehicles were not located.
