Possession of Forged Checks/Possession of Stolen Property/ Petty Theft:

On March 5, 2019, at approximately 1:08 pm, an Officer contacted a 24 year old male in the 1600 block of Partridge Drive. The subject was on probation out of San Mateo County, for theft, with a search clause. The subject was in possession of multiple items of mail from several addresses on Partridge Drive in Hercules. He also had some forged checks in his possession. One victim, from Partridge, was contacted and wished to pursue charges, against the subject, for having his mail. The subject was arrested, and later issued a citation and released. The Officer is still conducting follow up on the case.
