SUMMARY: On March 10, 2019, at approximately 7:42 am, Hercules Police Officers were dispatched to 1048 Crepe Myrtle in Hercules for the report of a male who had been stabbed. Officers learned the possible suspect was 37 year old Wesley Visor, and he was attempting to leave the residence. Officers arrived in the area, and located Visor in the 1000 block of Crepe Myrtle, walking away from the residence. Visor was detained and placed in a patrol vehicle. Officers continued to 1048 Crepe Myrtle to render aid to possible injured parties. Tyrone Avery, 66 years old, was contacted in front of the residence, and found to have multiple stab wounds to his upper left chest and shoulder area, and left arm. Officers provided medical treatment until personnel from Rodeo Hercules Fire Department arrived. Avery was transported by Ambulance to Lefty Gomez Field in Rodeo, and ultimately air lifted by helicopter to John Muir Hospital in Walnut Creek. Avery was in serious but stable condition. Visor was arrested for Assault with a Deadly Weapon, and transported to Contra Costa County Jail. The cause of the attack is still under investigation. Visor and Avery are related to each other and both reside at the address.
