Suspended Driver's License/Warrant Arrest/Towed Vehicle: On March 13, 2019 at 11:51 a.m. An Officer did a traffic stop on a Green '97 Honda Accord (Dealer paper plates), for no plates, on the E/B I-80 on-ramp from Willow Ave. The 27 year old male driver, of Stockton, was driving on a suspended driver's license. The 22 year old female right front passenger, of Oakland, had a cite releasable Misdemeanor Warrant out of San Jose P.D. The Warrant was issued on 11/05/2018. The male was cited for Driving on a Suspended License. The female was arrested for the warrant and cited with a new court date. Both subjects were released at the scene. The Accord was towed.

Warrant Arrest: On March 13, 2019 at 5:37 p.m. Officers were clearing a traffic stop on Sycamore Ave, near Claeys Ranch, when they were flagged down by a stranded motorist. Officers contacted four subjects inside of an SUV, which had run out of gas. Officers found an open container of Beer inside the vehicle. One of the occupants, a 66 year old male Transient, had a no cite Misdemeanor Warrant. The subject was arrested and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Robbery (In Custody): On March 13, 2019 at 6:15 p.m. Officers were dispatched to Starbucks, 3700 San Pablo Ave. for a civil stand by. Two parties were requesting a civil stand by so they could work out issues they had regarding a recent purchase of a vehicle. Officers learned one of the involved parties had just snatched and stolen a cell phone out of the hand of the girlfriend of the other involved party. The suspect then fled on foot from Starbucks towards Sycamore Ave. Officers located the 21 year old

male suspect, of Vallejo, in the 1500 block of Sycamore Ave. The stolen cell phone was located discarded nearby on Sycamore Ave. under I-80. The subject was arrested and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility. The stolen cell phone was returned to the victim.

Warrant Arrest: On March 14, 2019, at 2:01 am, an Officer stopped 32 year old male of Stockton, driving a silver 2007 Lexus RX3, for an equipment violation. The subject had an outstanding \$200,000 warrant, for possessing drugs for sale and for being a felon in possession of a firearm, from San Joaquin County. The subject is also on Felony Parole. He was arrested and transported to Martinez Detention Facility for the warrants. The 30 year old male passenger, of Stockton, was released at the scene.
