Hit and Run: On March 19, 2019, at approximately 9:08 am, an Officer was dispatched, to Coral Ridge Circle in Rodeo, for a hit and run collision which just occurred at Willow and Viewpointe in Hercules. The victim vehicle, a 2004 Toyota Corolla, was traveling east bound on Willow near Viewpointe. The victim vehicle turned north bound onto Viewpointe, and was struck in the intersection by the suspect vehicle, a newer model silver Dodge Ram. The victim vehicle had major damage to the passenger side rear door.

Warrant Arrest: On March 19, 2019, at approximately 1:19 pm, an Officer stopped a 2003 Ford Focus, on San Pablo Avenue near Tsushima, for an equipment violation. The 25 year old male driver, from Ceres, had an outstanding misdemeanor warrant from San Mateo County. The subject was arrested, and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Warrant Arrest: On March 19, 2019, at 8:52 pm, an officer stopped a 2000 Toyota Camry, for numerous equipment violations, at 1570 Sycamore Avenue (McDonald's lot).
