**Welfare Check:** On March 20, 2019, at approximately 12:05 pm, HPD Officers were dispatched to the 100 block of Sunflower Court in Hercules for a welfare check. The 86 year old male resident lives alone, and the neighbor heard him groaning and yelling inside the residence. Officers also heard the subject inside, but he was unable to get to the door. Officers were given permission, from the son, to force entry into the home. Fire responded, and determined the subject was not injured, just too weak to get up.

**Auto Burglary:** On March 20, 2019, at approximately 12:30 pm, an Officer was dispatched to Lucky for an auto burglary. Sometime between 8:00 am, and 12:00 pm, an unknown suspect broke the front passenger window to a 2013 Mercedes and stole an LG cell phone.

**Found Wallet:** On March 20, 2019, at approximately 11:57 am, an Officer responded to HPD for a found Wallet. On March 16, 2019, the reporting party found a wallet in Pinole which had a California driver's license in it for a resident of Hercules. The Officer was not able to make contact until after he had booked the wallet into safekeeping. The owner of the wallet was later contacted, and will respond to HPD at a later date to retrieve the wallet.

**Auto Burglary:** On March 21, 2019 at 11:45am, an officer was dispatched to the 600 block of Windsor to investigate an auto burglary. The reporting party parked and locked her vehicle at about 10:00pm last night in her designated parking stall. When she returned to her vehicle at about

11:45am this morning, she found the passenger door unlocked and the glove compartment open. Items from the glove compartment were scattered about the vehicle, the car's stereo had been removed.

**Auto Burglary:** On March 21, 2019 at 18:48pm, an officer was dispatched to 100 block of Oxford to investigate an auto burglary. The owner of the 2002 Honda Civic said he parked and locked his vehicle on March 18, 2019 at 9:00pm. This evening he noticed items missing from the vehicle. There was old damage to the door preventing the method of entry to be determined. Stolen were 10 soccer balls, and other soccer equipment.

**Auto Burglary:** On March 22, 2019 at 12:50am, an officer was dispatched to the 100 block of Rocky Point for a suspicious person on foot in the area looking in cars. The person also rang the reporting party's doorbell. Officers contacted a 20 year old male, who lives in the area. He said he was a neighbor who attempted to make contact regarding the reporting party's car door being open. The reporting party did not desire a report for a missing jacket and there was no damage to their vehicle. The subject also reported a broken window to a 2010 Mercedes parked on the street. The Mercedes' owner was contacted and he was unable to locate any missing items. The time frame is between March 21, 2019 at 8:30pm and time of call.

**Auto Burglary:** On March 21, 2019 at 1:13am, an officer was dispatched to the 2000 block of Lewis to investigate a vehicle with a smashed window. The 2012 Mazda belongs to a resident in the area. The owner was contacted and he said he parked his vehicle on March 21, 2019 at 7:30pm and it was not damaged. He said a gym bag with a yoga mat and other miscellaneous items were missing from the vehicle.

**Found Property (Hand Gun):** On March 22, 2019 at 7:35am an officer was dispatched to Sycamore Ave at Claeys Ranch regarding a found pistol. Landscapers, working in the area, located a semi-automatic pistol as they were clearing brush from the area. The weapons was booked as found property.

**Occupied Stolen Vehicle:** On March 22, 2019 at 7:23am, officers were dispatched to the 100 block of Agate. The caller reported an occupied black Mercedes had been parked in the area since last night. Officers conducted a records check on the Mercedes and were advised the vehicle was reported stolen, to Oakland PD, on March 4, 2019. A 36 year old male, of Oakland, was the sole occupant of the vehicle. The subject was arrested. and booked into County Jail.

**Lost Property (Wallet):** On March 22, 2019, a Hercules resident came to HPD to report he lost his wallet (containing his identifying information) somewhere near 828 Willow.

**Auto Burglary:** On March 22, 2019, at approximately 7:30 pm, an Officer was dispatched to the 3600 San Pablo Avenue for an auto burglary. Sometime between 2:10 pm, and 7:30 pm, an unknown suspect broke the rear driver's side window of a 2008 Toyota Matrix, and took a backpack from the back seat of the vehicle.

**Driving Under the Influence:** On March 22, 2019, at approximately 8:47 pm, HPD Officers were dispatched to Willow Avenue for a possible impaired driver who was seen exiting Highway 80 east bound at Willow Avenue. The vehicle was a black Chrysler 4 door. An Officer located the vehicle at 76 Gas Station, and contacted the 42 year old driver. The subject was uncooperative, and displayed objective signs of alcohol intoxication. The subject refused to do any tests. He had an injury to his right shoulder, and it appeared he had been involved in an accident, and there was fresh damage to the front of the car. The subject was placed under arrest, for Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol. He was transported out to the County Regional Medical Center due to a possible collision and injury. Officers checked the surrounding area and were not able to locate any evidence of where a collision may have occurred. A blood draw search warrant was authored and signed. The subject was medically cleared and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

**Auto Burglary:** On March 23, 2019 at 8:59am an officer was dispatched to the 100 block of Chestnut to investigate an auto burglary. Sometime after 6:00pm yesterday, an unknown suspect(s) pried open two diamond plated tool boxes that were attached to his truck. Taken from the boxes was a spray gun and five gallons of paint.

**Domestic Violence:** On March 23, 2019 officers were dispatched to the 200 block of Bobolink to investigate a possible Domestic Violence case. The caller told CHP 911 operators her husband hit her and hung up. Prior to officer making contact at the residence, the female called our dispatch and said her husband had left the residence and she no longer needed our assistant. Officers arrived and contacted the adult female. The female had a small cut to the bridge of her nose and redness in her face. She was uncooperative and would not provide officers with any information about why she called 911 or how she received her injuries. She declined medical assistance. Case taken for domestic violence for documentation. .

**Warrant Arrest:** On March 23, 2019, an officer contacted a 64 year old male, at his home in the 100 block of Robin Ct, and cited him for his misdemeanor warrant. The warrant was related to this agency's case.

**Auto Burglary:** On March 23, 2019 at 2:29pm an officer was dispatched to the 1100 block of North Shelter Bay to investigate a window smash auto burglary. The reporting party parked her 2013 Rogue sometime after 8:00pm yesterday. She came out to her vehicle today and saw that an unknown suspect(s) had shattered the window of her vehicle.

**Carry Concealed loaded stolen firearm, not registered owner/**

**Possession of stolen property:** On March 23, 2019 at 11:44pm, an officer conducted a traffic stop on a blue 2003 Toyota Camry for equipment violations. The officer contacted the 20 year old male driver. The officer observed a black handgun, on the driver's floor board, immediately accessible to the driver. The four occupants of the vehicle were detained, and the hand gun was secured. The driver was arrested and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility. The other occupants were released on scene.

**Auto Burglary:** On March 25, 2019, at 5:48 am, a citizen called to report their vehicle had been burglarized within the last few minutes, while parked in the Starbucks parking lot of 3700 San Pablo Avenue. The passenger side window to their green Ford Fusion was shattered and an iPad, laptop, and purse were stolen.

**Lost Property:** On March 25, 2019 at 10:09 am, an Officer was dispatched to HPD for a Lost Property report. The Hercules resident reported his Brazilian Passport lost sometime between October 1, 2018 and today. He last saw it before he moved from San Jose to Hercules.

**Attempted Robbery:** On March 25, 2019 at 11:31 am, HPD units were dispatched to an attempted robbery at the 76 Gas Station, located at 828 Willow Ave. The suspect was described as an African American; 5-09; 170-200 lbs; wearing blue hooded jacket, blue jeans and a white mask over his face. The suspect entered the store, pulled the white mask over his head, and approached the cashier. He asked for all the money and he had his hand underneath his shirt with something pointed at her. She asked the suspect if he was going to rob her. He then fled on foot prior to police arrival and ran to a blue Toyota Camry parked on the on ramp to eastbound I-80 and drove away.

**Auto Burglary:** On March 25, 2019 at 5:15pm, an Officer was dispatched to The Home Depot, located at 1625 Sycamore Ave, for an auto burglary

report. The victim parked and locked his silver 2003 2-Door Honda Civic, in the Home Depot parking lot, this morning. When returned to his vehicle at 5:15pm, he discovered his driver side rear quarter window had been smashed and his black back pack and two drills were missing from the back seat of his vehicle.

**Found Property:** On March 26, 2019 at 7:47 a.m. An Officer responded to the 100 block of Pecan to recover found property. The reporting party found mail on the ground near 109 Pecan.

**Impounded Vehicle/Possession of a Controlled Substance/Drug**

**Paraphernalia:** On March 26, 2019 at 8:23 a.m. an Officer stopped a white 2005 Chevy Van on westbound I-80 from John Muir. The registration for the Van was expired over six months but a current registration tab was attached the plate. During a inventory search of the Van, the Officer located a substance, suspected to be a narcotic, and drug paraphernalia. The 50 year old male driver, of Vacaville, and was later cited and release.

**Found Property:** On March 26, 2019 at 11:24 a.m. An Officer was dispatched to the 100 block of Dogwood Ct. for mail dumped near a fire hydrant. The Officer located opened, and unopened mail, from the Lupine Rd. and Redwood Rd. area. The Officer collected the mail and contacted US Postal Inspector, who will pick up the found mail.

**Stolen License Plates:** On March 26, 2019 at 3:10 p.m. An Officer was dispatched to the 800 block of Dover St. to take a report for two stolen license plates. The victim said an unknown suspect stole the two license plates assigned to her '07 Infiniti G35. The vehicle was parked in her assigned carport. The theft occurred sometime March 23, 2019 and the time of call.

**Warrant Arrest:** On March 26, 2019, at 8:03 pm, Hercules Officers responded to the 100 block of Coventry for a report of an intoxicated person. The 53 year old female, was argumentative and causing a disturbance. She was found to have an outstanding misdemeanor warrant. She was taken into custody and transported to The Martinez Detention Facility.

**Residential Burglary:** On March 26, 2019, at 8:44 pm, Hercules Officers responded to the 100 block of Skelly for a report of a residential burglary which occurred between 4:30 pm to the time of call. The suspect used the resident's ladder to enter the house through an unsecured second story window in the backyard. Loss included Jewelry and electronics.

**Missing Person:** On March 26, 2019, at 11:53 pm, an officer was dispatched to the 1900 block of Lupine Road for a missing person report. A 30 year old female, and her 2 year old daughter, are Richmond residents, but were visiting her aunt in Hercules. At 7:30 am, this morning the aunt noticed the two females had left and borrowed her black 2005 Honda CRV. The Missing Person had a cell phone with her, but is not answering it. When she had not returned tonight the aunt got concerned and called the police. On March 28, 2019 both subjects were located and found to be safe and well.

**Driving Under the Influence:** On March 27, 2019, at 2:38 am, an Officer stopped 33 year old male, of Vallejo, while driving a 1988 Toyota Corolla for a traffic violation. Investigation determined the subject was intoxicated beyond the presumptive limit permitted for operating a motor vehicle. He refused to cooperate with testing and a DUI Blood Draw Warrant was approved by a judge. After the blood draw the subject was transported to the Martine Detention Facility.

**Identity Theft:** On March 27, 2019 at 8:28am, a Hercules resident came to HPD to report his identifying information had been compromised. An unknown suspect obtained a personal loan from Discover using his identity

**Traffic Collision (Non-Injury):** On March 27, 2019 at 8:41am, officers were dispatched to Willow at Palm for a non-jury collision. The involved vehicles were a 2019 Dodge and a 2001 Toyota Camry. The collision caused major damage to both vehicle.

**Contraband Taken for Destruction:** On March 28, 2019 2:29pm, an officer went to the 100 block of Trellis Bay to recover found narcotics. The reporting party was cleaning out a vehicle and found the drugs inside. The small amount of drugs was taken for destruction.

**Located Missing Person:** On March 29, 2019 at approximately 12:38am, Officers were dispatched to the 200 block Shipwatch Ln. for an outside assist for Albany PD. Albany PD requested we attempt to make contact a 38 year old adult missing person who had recently walked away from a rehab center in Oakland. Officers contacted the subject, who was in good health and did not appear to be in crisis.

**Court Order Violation:** On March 29, 2019 at 3:01pm, an officer was dispatched to Lupine Hills Elementary regarding a child custody exchange. Per a court order, the father was to pick up the child at 3:00pm today. When he arrived he was told by the school that the grandmother (mother's

side) had already signed the child out. The father believes this violates the court order.

**Warrant Arrest:** On March 20 2019 at approximately 11:12pm an Officer stopped a silver 2017 Honda Civic, for having no license plates, on Willow Ave over Highway 4. The 37 year old male driver, of Vallejo. The subject had two warrants for his arrest out of Solano County. The subject was taken into custody and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

**Domestic Violence:** On March 31, 2019 at approximately 12:11am, Officers were dispatched to the 200 block Coronado St. for a report of a disturbance in front of the residence. Officers contacted 20 year old female victim, in the front yard of the residence. The victim stated she had been in an altercation with her 20 year old boyfriend, who had left the area prior to Officers arrival. The victim said the suspect pinned her down on the bed and then slapped her across her face. The victim had visible injuries and requested to press charges. An Emergency Protective Order was granted by a judge. Officers were unable to locate or make contact with the suspect at the time of the incident.

**Natural Death:** On March 31, 2019, at 9:07 pm, the fire department requested Hercules Officers respond to the 200 block of Nutmeg Court for a report of a 66 year old female, who was declared deceased after lifesaving measures failed. The subject reportedly had several medical issues. The Contra Costa County Coroner's Office released the body to the family.
