**Mail Theft/Forgery:** On April 29, 2019, at approximately 8:19 am, an Officer handled a lobby detail regarding mail theft. A resident from the 100 block of Starling Way said, sometime between April 9, 2019 and April 29, 2019, an unknown suspect took his mail from his mailbox. The victim was expecting checks which he never received. He learned some of those checks were fraudulently used to attempt to make purchases at department stores.

**Petty Theft:** On April 29, 2019, at approximately 9:54 am, an Officer handled a lobby detail for a theft of a package. A resident from the 1000 block of Rock Harbor Point never received a package she ordered. USPS said the package was delivered on April 26, 2019, at approximately 1:34 pm.

**Warrant Arrest:** On April 29, 2019, at approximately 11:22 pm, HPD Officers were dispatched to the 100 block of Crestridge Court for a male who was trying to get into his grandparent's home. Officers contacted the 36 year old male in front of the residence. The subject had an outstanding misdemeanor warrant. He was arrested and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

**Injury Collision:** On April 29, 2019, at approximately 2:11 pm, HPD Officers were dispatched to the area of Lupine and Poppy for the report of a head on collision. Officers contacted a 20 year old male, sitting on the sidewalk on Lupine. The subject was bleeding from his nose and face. Rodeo Hercules Fire arrived, and treated the subject. He was later transported, by AMR, to a hospital. An Officer contacted a 36 year old male, standing next to his 2010 Toyota Tacoma Pick-up. The subject said he fell asleep, while driving a truck southbound on Lupine. He crossed over into the northbound traffic lane hitting the other driver's 2009 Honda Accord head on. The air bags deployed in both vehicles. The other driver did not have any visible injuries.

**Warrant Arrest:** On April 29, 2019, at approximately 4:01 pm, HPD Officers were dispatched to Home Depot for a theft in progress. Home Depot asset protection detained a 49 year old male for theft of some power tools. Officers determined the subject had an outstanding misdemeanor warrant from Fremont Police department. The subject was arrested for the

warrant and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility. Home Depot handled the theft internally.

**Lost Property:** On April 29, 2019, at approximately 6:05 pm, an Officer handled a lobby detail for lost property. Sometime, between 7:30 pm, and 8:30 pm, on April 28, 2019, a Hercules resident lost his wallet while he was walking near Victoria Crescent East.

**Hit & Run (BobCop):** On April 29, 2019, at 8:44 pm, a citizen made an online report stating a green Toyota Rav4 collided into the rear of her brown Honda Civic, causing minor damage. The incident occurred while she was stopped at in the 1600 block of Refugio Valley Road. The citizen pulled over and the other party drove away.

**Recovered - Occupied Stolen Vehicle:** On April 29, 2019, at 8:48 pm, an Officer stopped 21 year old male, of Oakland, driving a gray 2000 Honda Accord for displaying a rear paper plate. The stop occurred at the Park in Ride in the 800 block of Willow Avenue. The Honda was reported as a "Carjacking" vehicle from Oakland P. D. on April 15, 2019. The driver's 24 year old wife, of San Francisco, was in the passenger seat. Both subjects were detained. The female was released. The male suspect was arrested and transported to Martinez Detention Facility.
