Warrant Arrest: On April 30, 2019, at 7:45am, an officer made a traffic stop on a 2015 Honda Accord. The stop was on Refugio Valley Rd and Miramar, for a stop sign violation. The 47 year old male driver had an outstanding Probable Cause warrant for a 2018 Hercules case. The subject was transported to Hercules PD where he was interviewed by a Detective. He was later released, pending further investigation.

Possession of a Controlled Substance/Drug Paraphernalia: On April 30, 2019, at 10:48am, an officer checked an occupied a 1998 Honda Accord, in the parking lot of Home Depot. The occupants were a 20 year old male, and a 26 year old male. The 26 year old told the officer he was in possession of a narcotic substance. The officer searched the 26 year old and located a small plastic baggy, containing a suspected narcotic; and a glass pipe, commonly used to smoke narcotics. The subject was arrested and later released on a citation.

Prisoner Pick-up: On April 30, 2019, at 12:40pm, the Parking Enforcement Officer went to Solano County Jail and picked up a 30 year old male, on a felony warrant, out of this City. The Subject was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Package Theft: On April 30, 2019, at approximately 3:58 PM, an officer was dispatched to the 2100 block of Lupine Road in regards to a theft of three packages. The officer canvased the area for evidence and nothing was located.

Guns for destruction: On April 30, 2019 at 5:52 PM, a citizen arrived at the station to turn in three shotguns for destruction. The owner of the firearms passed away, and the spouse did not want them.

Collision: On May 1, 2019, at 8:40 am, while an Officer was on a traffic stop on Lupine Road facing north bound, a vehicle passed on the left, and struck the Officers driver's door. There were no injuries as a result of the collision.

Shoplifting: On May 1, 2019, at approximately 9:02 am, HPD Officers were dispatched to Home Depot for a theft which just occurred, and the suspect was still sitting in a gold van in the parking lot. Officers contacted a 32 year old female, in a gold Toyota Sienna. The subject was positively identified as the person who took merchandise without paying for it from Home Depot. The merchandise was located in the vehicle. The subject was arrested and later issued a citation and released.

Coroners Case: On May 1, 2019 at 7:02pm, Officers were dispatched to the 200 block of Bobolink for a report of an unresponsive female. On arrival Officers located a 93 year old female, in her bed. The subject had recently been removed from hospice and had a posted Do Not Resuscitate order. No life saving measures were performed due to the DNR. The Contra Costa County Coroner's Office was contacted the body was released to the family.

Possession of controlled substance: On May 1, 2019 at 8:57pm, an Officer conducted a pedestrian stop in the area of 1500 Sycamore Ave. The 23 year old male is a local transient. and is on searchable probation out of San Mateo County. A search of the subject's person reveal a small plastic baggie containing a substance believed to be a narcotic. The subject admitted that the substance was a narcotic and he was placed under arrest. He was issued a citation and released at the scene.

Warrant Arrest: On May 2, 2019 at approximately 2:30am, an Officer stopped a black 2000 Honda Accord for multiple vehicle code violation. The 31 year old male driver, out of Sacramento, had a no bail warrant out of Sacramento County. The 31 year old passenger, out of Sacramento, was found to have a no cite warrant out of Sacramento. Both subjects were taken in to custody and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.
