Prisoner Pick-Up: On April 8, 2019, a parking enforcement Officer went to Santa Rita Jail to pick up a 28 year old male for a Misdemeanor warrant held by Hercules PD. The subject was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility and booked.

Theft by False Pretense: On April 8, 2019, at approximately 2:24 pm, an Officer handled a lobby detail for a theft. The reporting party received a call from a person saying they were from Apple and said her computer had been hacked. The caller convinced the reporting party to buy two Google play gift cards. She also gave the person her credit card number. The credit card has been cancelled, but the gift cards were redeemed.

CRIME PREVENTION TIP: Beware of anyone who calls you about your computer being hacked; infected with a virus; or anything which requires them to “make a fix” on your computer. Be particularly suspicious if the caller wants you to pay for a service by buying “Google Play Gifts Card” or any prepaid credit or gift card. Repairable vendors do not asked for payment with “gift cards”. Do not give out any personal information and hang up on the caller.

Reported Sounds of Shots Fired: On April 9, 2019, at 0145 hours, officers responded to the area of **Mandalay** for a report of shots fired. Additional callers from **Grenadine** and **Florence Court** also reported hearing shots. After an extensive search, officers were unable to locate a scene.
