**Driving a Vehicle without Specified Ignition Device:** On June 17, 2019, at approximately 7:49 am, an Officer stopped a 2003 Buick, in the 4000 block of San Pablo Avenue, for expired registration. The 43 year old male driver, from Hercules, had a restricted driver's license requiring any vehicle he drives to have an ignition device installed to measure if there is any alcohol in his system. The subject was driving a vehicle which did not have a device. He was issued a citation and released. His wife drove the car away.

**Identity Theft:** On June 17, 2019, at approximately 10:06 am, an Officer was dispatched to HPD lobby for an identity theft. The Officer contacted a 46 year old female who stated, between January 16, 2019, and June 13, 2019, an unknown suspect opened a Discover credit card account in her name, and charged \$1,916.94 to the card. The victim learned of this when she received a call from Discover saying her credit card bill was overdue, and she did not have a Discover credit card. The account was opened online.

**Domestic Violence Restraining Order Violation:** On June 17, 2019, at approximately 10:35 am, an Officer was dispatched to HPD Lobby for a Domestic Violence Restraining Order violation. The adult reporting party, and her mother, are both protected parties in a restraining order. A 25 year old male is the restrained party in the order. The restrained party called the mother's phone, and spoke with both parties. They hung up after they told the suspect he was in violation of the order for even calling them.

**Identity Theft:** On June 17, 2019, at approximately 2:27 pm, an Officer was dispatched to the 300 block of Violet Road for an identity theft. The Officer contacted the reporting party who said on June 12<sup>th</sup> she received an alert from Equifax stating a person in Texas attempted to obtain a loan using her information. The transaction did not go through. On June 17<sup>th</sup> the victim received a letter from Movo confirming a new credit card opened in her name. The victim was able to cancel the card without having any charges on it.

**Evading a Police Officer:** On June 17, 2019, at 8:40 p.m., an Officer attempted to stop a silver 2001 Lexus, at 800 Willow Avenue, for expired registration. The 46 year old male driver, of Oakland, failed to yield and a slow speed pursuit was initiated. The subject yielded on California Street at Tullibee Road in Rodeo (distance of 1 mile). The driver and front passenger, a 33 year old male of Oakland,

were on probation out of Alameda Count. One of the occupants threw a pill bottle out of the vehicle during the pursuit that was later located and determined to be drug paraphernalia. The vehicle was secured and left parked at the scene. The two subjects were released pending a complaint with the DA's Office.

**Cold Petty Theft:** On June 18, 2019, at 5:20 a.m., an Officer requested a case for a theft of a "Ring" camera that occurred in the 2000 block of Lupine Road on June 15, 2019, at 8:20 p.m.

**Warrant Arrest:** On June 18, 2019, at 6:04 a.m., an Officer stopped 27 year old male, of Hercules, while driving a 2008 Chrysler PT Cruiser, on San Pablo Avenue at Hercules Avenue for a vehicle code violation. The subject was found to have two outstanding warrants for his. He was transported to Martinez Detention Facility for the warrants.

**Special Olympics Torch Run:** This afternoon several members of the Hercules Police Department will participate in the Annual Special Olympics Torch Run. The Hercules runners will receive the Torch, from Pinole Police Department's runners, at approximately 2:45pm, at Tennent and San Pablo Ave, Pinole.
