Auto Burglary: On June 19, 2019, at 9:06am, and Officer was dispatched to the 100 block of Jasper Ct. for an auto burglary. The reporting party stated between June 18, 2019 at 7:00pm, and June 19, 2019 at 7:00am, an unknown suspect(s) broke into his 2013 Chevy work van. The loss was electronics and tools.

Possession of Burglary Tools and Probation Violation On June 20th 2019 at approximately 1:06AM HPD Officers were dispatched to the area of Emerald Way and Agate for two suspicious subjects walking around the area. They were described as two males in dark clothing. Officers contacted a 20 year old male, of Richmond; and a 38 year old male, of Richmond. The younger subject was determined to be on probation for auto theft. A consent search was conducted and burglary tools were discovered on the younger male. He was placed under arrest and transported to the Martine Detention Facility.

Coroner's Case: On June 20, 2019 at 0800 hours, HPD units were dispatched the 200 block of Meadowlark Way for a coroner's case. Fire was on scene and the 48 year old male was pronounced deceased at 8:04am. The subject was believed to have previous medical issues and no foul play was suspected. The Coroner released the body to the family.

Prisoner Transport: On June 20, 2019 at about 1021 hours, the Parking Enforcement Officer went to the Santa Clara County Jail to pick up a 44 year old male on a Hercules Warrant and transported him to the Martine Detention Facility.

Warrant Arrest: On June 20, 2019 at 10:31am, an officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle that had expired registration. The 22 year old female driver had a "No Bail" warrant for grand theft. The passenger took the vehicle. The driver was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Battery: On June 20, 2019 at 10:51, an officer responded to HPD for a battery report. The incident occurred in the 200 block of Stone Pine Ct. on June 14, 2019. The 20 year old female, reporting party, stated she got into an argument with her mother's 31 year old girlfriend. The older female started pushing the younger female. The younger female punched the other woman and sprained her own left shoulder, left wrist and fingers. The

younger woman wanted to press charges and signed a Complaint form. The other party was contacted and arrived at HPD. She had photos of trauma to her face by punched by the younger female. The other party also signed a Complaint form.

Identity Theft: On June 20, 2019 at 6:28pm, an Officer arrived at HPD for a lobby detail regarding an identity theft case. The victim received a call, from the alleged Social Security Office, telling him his Social Security number had been fraudulently used. He confirmed his number and his home address, to the suspect. The victim was given an Identity Theft pamphlet and advised to contact the major creditors and monitor his credit.

Found Property: On June 21, 2019, at about 9:05 am, an officer was flagged down by an anonymous citizen who turned over two license plates that he found on the walking trail in Rodeo that parallels Parker Ave. A records check indicated that the plates had not been reported lost or stolen. The plates were taken for safekeeping and will be sent back to DMV. **(H19-1053)**

Natural Death: On June 21, 2019, at about 12:58 pm, officers responded to a residence in the 1500 block of Sycamore Ave for a report of a subject not breathing. The property manager found the 73 year old male, in his apartment, unresponsive and not breathing. Officers located the subject and Medical personnel pronounced him deceased at 1:18 pm. There were no signs of foul play. The Coroner released the body to the family.

Check Fraud: On June 21, 2019, at about 5:27 pm, an officer responded to the HPD lobby for a reported fraud. The victim stated she checked her online checking account and noticed that a check number she still had in her possession was cashed in the amount of \$322 yesterday.

Lost Property On June 21st 2019 at approximately 8:02PM a HPD Officer took a courtesy phone report for an Apple iPad that was lost at the Newark Airport in New Jersey. The iPad was entered into the Automated Property System.

Possession of a Controlled Substance/Probation Violation: On June 21st 2019 at approximately 8:23PM a HPD Officer contacted a 36 year old male, of Hayward, in the parking lot of the Home Depot. The subject was on probation, out of Alameda County. During a compliance check, a substance, suspected to be a narcotic, was discovered in his pant pocket. He was cite/released at the scene.

Unauthorized use of an access card On June 22, 2019 at approximately 1:56 a HPD Officer was dispatched to a residence in the 200 block of Violet Rd for a report of a possible identity theft. It was determined one of the victim's credit cards was used without permission.

Recovered Stolen Vehicle On June 22, 2019 at approximately 4:12PM a HPD Officer was dispatched to the 200 block of Dorada Ct for a stolen vehicle recovery. A white 2012 Ford Taurus, which had been under a car cover, was determined to have been reported stolen to Oakland PD on May 16, 2019.

Recovered Stolen Vehicle On June 22, 2019 at approximately 4:33PM a HPD Officer was dispatched to the lobby to contact the victim of stolen vehicle who had recovered her own vehicle in Oakland.

Warrant Arrest: On June 22nd 2019 at approximately 10:12PM HPD Officers were dispatched to the 3700 block of San Pablo Ave for a 911 call with a large disturbance heard in the background. Officers determined there was an altercation between the owner of a business and a group of females. During the incident, the owner was punched on the head by

one of the females. No injuries were seen and medical attention was declined. The victim did not wish to press charges and just wanted the subjects admonished. A 28 year old female, of Sacramento, was taken into custody on a no bail traffic warrant held by Vallejo PD. She was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Restraining Oder Violation On June 23rd 2019, at approximately 1:51AM, HPD Officers were dispatched to the 2100 block of Lupine Road for a report of a 21 year old male , out of Stockton, knocking at the front door attempting to contact the 20 year old female resident. It was determined male was a restrained party in a served criminal protective order. The female was the protected party. Officers located, and detained, the male in front of the residence. The female wished prosecution against Blanton and signed a complainant's arrest form. The subject was taken into custody and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Courtesy Report: On June 23, 2019, at approximately 9:03 am, an Officer was dispatched to the 1000 block of Promenade Street for an Outside Assist for San Jose Police Department. The Officer contacted the registered owner of a 1999, Honda Civic, which had been parked in San Jose, blocking a driveway, and the ignition was damaged. The subject said his vehicle was not supposed to be where it was, and someone must have stolen it. San Jose PD asked HPD to take a courtesy report for the vehicle theft since the owner was in Hercules, and needed to sign the form. A courtesy report was taken and the Honda was entered into the Stolen Vehicle System.
