**Ammunition for Destruction:** On June 25, 2019, at approximately 9:08 am, an Officer was dispatched to HPD Lobby for ammunition being turned in for destruction. The ammunition was booked at HPD for destruction.

**Shoplifting:** On June 25, 2019, at approximately 10:41 am, HPD Officers were dispatched to Rite Aid for a theft which just occurred. The suspect was described as an African Americana male adult; approximately 5'0". The subject left towards San Pablo Avenue in gray colored Camaro. The loss was valued at approximately \$50.00.

**Identity Theft:** On June 25, 2019, at approximately 12:00 pm, an Officer handled a lobby detail for an identity theft. A Hercules resident said her deceased husband opened several credit accounts in her name without her knowledge just before he died.

**Assault with a Deadly Weapon:** On June 25, 2019, at approximately 1:37 pm, HPD Officers were dispatched, to the 200 block of Meadowlark, for an assault which just occurred. Officers arrived and contacted the 55 year old male victim in in the 100 block of Meadowlark. The victim had a large laceration to his right forearm area. The victim stated a 59 year old male hit him with a hammer. The suspect was reportedly in the backyard of the residence in the 200 block of Meadowlark. The suspect was located and detained. The subject was arrested for assault with a deadly weapon and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility. The victim was transported to a hospital for treatment of his injuries.

**Missing Person:** On June 25, 2019, at approximately 5:02 pm, an Officer was dispatched to the 1900 block of Redwood Road for the report of a Missing Person. The reporting party said he has not talked to his 40 year old son in three days. The Officer called the subject's cell phone and there was no answer.

**Attempted Residential Burglary:** On June 25, 2019, at approximately 5:42 pm an Officer was dispatched to the 100 block of Brenner for the report of a possible residential burglary. The Officer observed pry marks to the front door indicating someone tried to force the front door open. The incident occurred between 4:30 am and 5:40 pm.

**Private Property Damage:** On June 25, 2019, at 9:07 p.m., an HOA member, from Forest Run, called to state three large tree branches fell onto two parked vehicles: a white 2002 Toyota pickup and a red 1990 Nissan pickup. There were no injuries.

**Vehicle vs. Vehicle Collision:** On June 26, 2019, at 2:56 a.m., a black Toyota Corolla collided into the rear of a white Volkswagen while traveling westbound on Willow Avenue at Palm. The driver of the Volkswagen complained of back pain, but declined medical treatment.
