**Found Property:** On June 26, 2019, at approximately 12:19 pm, an Officer handled a lobby detail for found property. On June 11, at approximately 5:00 pm, a Hercules resident found a Samsung Galaxy S7 cell phone in the bottom of the pool on Miramar. The phone was collected and booked into safekeeping at HPD.

**Shoplifting:** On June 26, 2019, at approximately 2:22 pm, an Officer was dispatched to Lucky for a cold shoplifting report. The Officer was told two African American female adults pushed out a shopping cart, full of meat, without paying for any of the items. The suspects got into a tan 2001, Chevy Malibu and drove away.

**Lost Property (BobCop):** On June 26, 2019, at approximately 4:24 pm an online report was taken for a lost wallet, on a West Cat bus.

**Auto Burglary (BobCop):** On June 26, 2019, at approximately 5:04 pm, an On-line report was taken for an auto burglary. Sometime between May 13, 2019, at approximately 10:00 pm, and May 14, at approximately 4:00 am, and unknown suspect broke the driver's side rear window of a 2004 Subaru and stole a backpack.

**Warrant Arrest:** On June 26, 2019, at approximately 5:18 pm, an Officer contacted a 44 year old male, on Orchid Court. The Officer was aware the subject had a misdemeanor warrant held by HPD. The subject was arrested and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

**Lost Property:** On June 26, 2019, at approximately 5:21 pm, an Officer was dispatched to the 200 block of Palermo for lost property. The reporting party said, sometime between 1:45 pm, and 5:21 pm, he left his wallet and iPhone on the roof of his car, and drove away from the Dog Park on Turquoise Drive.

**Warrant Arrest** On June 26<sup>th</sup> 2019 at approximately 8:28PM a HPD Officer checked on a suspicious white 2018 Mercedes, in the 3900 block of San Pablo Ave. During the course of the contact, a 30 year old male, of Yuba City, was taken into custody on a warrant held by Walnut Creek PD. He was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

**Prisoner Pick up** On June 26<sup>th</sup> 2019 at approximately 11:30PM a HPD Officer responded to Elmwood Correctional Facility, in Milpitas, to pick up (a 40 year old female, on our warrant, for burglary. She was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

**Vandalism:** A citizen reported her vehicle being vandalized on "Bobcop". She was contacted via telephone and stated someone engraved an explicit word on the side of her Mercedes while being parked at the Bart lot on June 21, 2019.

**Grand Theft:** On June 27, 2019 at 1506 hours, an Officer arrived at HPD for a lobby detail regarding a grand theft case. The Hercules resident stated her friend stole her wedding ring, wedding band, and several vintage baseball cards.

**Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol Collision** On June 27<sup>th</sup> 2019 at approximately 7:32PM HPD Officers were dispatched to a vehicle collision in the area of San Pablo Ave and Hercules Ave. Officers located a 2009 Jeep which had slowly backed into a 2002 Honda Civic. The 51 year old male driver, of the Jeep of Palo Alto, displayed objective symptoms of being under the influence of alcohol. The subject was given the Standard Field Sobriety Test; the Preliminary Alcohol Screening device indicated he was over the presumptive limit for the purposes of driving. He was placed under arrest and later cite released to a responsible party. No injuries were sustained.

**Warrant Arrest:** On June 28, 2019 at 9:22 a.m. Hercules Officers went to the 100 block of Aralia Ct. to serve an outstanding Felony Warrant on a 34 year old male, of Hercules. Officers spoke to the subject, on the phone, and asked him to come home. The subject returned home and was arrested. The Warrant was issued on May 6, 2019, out of Martinez PD. The subject was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

**Warrant Arrest:** On June 28, 2019 at 12:19 p.m. Hercules Officers were dispatched to Shell gas station, 3900 San Pablo Ave. for a report of a possible vehicle theft. The reporting party stated she left her keys inside the vehicle and someone stole it. Officers located the vehicle backed in near the vacuums. The vehicle had a flat right rear tire and the car keys were found lying on the ground next to the tire. Officers checked the area and did not locate the reporting party. Officers found a purse, left inside the vehicle. Inside the officer found a MasterCard, in the name of a 33 year old female of Richmond. An Officer contacted the registered owner of the vehicle and she advised a family member would be en-route to pick up the vehicle. A 35 year old male arrived to pick up the car. He had an outstanding cite releasable Misdemeanor Warrant issued on June 14, 2019. He was cited and released before being given the car keys. An Officer contacted owner of the MasterCard, via cell phone, but she refused to respond to pick-up her MasterCard. The MasterCard was placed into Evidence as Safekeeping at HPD.

**Warrant Arrest** On June 28<sup>th</sup> 2019 at approximately 8:20PM a HPD Officer was conducting a vehicle release when it was discovered that the registered owner of the vehicle, a 31 year old female of Martinez, had a no bail warrant out of Solano County. She was taken into custody and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility

**Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol:** On June 29<sup>th</sup> 2019 at approximately 12:07AM HPD Officers were dispatched to the area of Sycamore Ave and Lupine Rd for a possible intoxicated driver in a silver Toyota Tacoma. Officers located the vehicle and the adult male driver, of Hercules. He displayed the objective symptoms of alcohol intoxication. He was given the Standard Field Sobriety Test; and the Preliminary Alcohol Screening device indicated the subject was over the presumptive limit for the purposes of driving. The subject was arrested and later cite/released to a responsible party.

**Theft from Unlocked Vehicle:** On June 29, 2019, at approximately 7:50 am, an Officer was dispatched to Burger King located at 836 Willow for a theft from a vehicle. Sometime between 7:20 am, and 7:50 am, a male went into an unlocked 2000 Honda, parked in the parking lot, and stole some miscellaneous items and medication. The suspect vehicle was described as a black newer model Honda. A witness said there was another male involved. The witness did not stay in the area, and would not leave their info with the victim. Officers checked the area and were not able to locate the suspect vehicle.

**Theft of Package:** On June 29, 2019, at approximately 12:37 pm, an Officer was dispatched to the 300 block of North Front for the report of a theft of a package. Sometime between 9:55 am, and 10:55 am, an unknown person stole a package from the porch. The package was located down the street and two items were found to be missing from the package.

**Vehicle Pursuit:** On June 30, 2019, at 3:56 a.m., dispatch relayed receiving a Automated License Plate Reader Hit on a stolen vehicle, a gray 4 door 2015 Ford Fusion, traveling eastbound on I-80 at Appian Way. The vehicle was reported stolen to CHP-Oakland on June 29, 2019. A Hercules officer located the vehicle as it exited the freeway near the BART lot on Willow Avenue. The driver accelerated away from the officer and a pursuit was initiated. The driver entered westbound Hwy-4, turned left on San Pablo Avenue, made a U-turn, and re-entered the freeway, eastbound I-80 where the pursuit was terminated at the Vallejo Bridge.

**Driving Under the influence of Alcohol/Collision:** On June 30, 2019, at 5:01 a.m., officers received a call that a silver 2007 Volkswagen Golf collided, into two parked vehicles, in the 300 block of Violet Road. The occupants of the Golf declined medical attention. The 18 year old female driver displayed objective symptoms of intoxication. She was given the Standard Field Sobriety Test; and was unable to complete the testing for the Preliminary Alcohol Screening device. She was arrested and was cited and released to a family member.

**Found Property:** On June 30, 2019, at approximately 12:36 pm, an Officer was dispatched to the Grove Church located at 960 Willow Avenue for Found Property. The Reporting party showed the Officer a pile of bags and some luggage in the southeast corner of the parking lot. The Officer located credit cards, two passports, and some other random cards in different names. The Officer was able to contact one person who was the victim of an Auto Burglary in San Jose. The victim came to HPD and retrieved several items of his property. The Officer left a message for the case Officer from San Jose PD, and booked the rest of the found property at HPD.

**Prisoner Pick-up:** On June 30, 2019, at 9:51 p.m., an officer responded to Santa Rita Jail to pick up a 51 year old male, of Richmond, who was being held on an outstanding warrant regarding our case. The subject was transported to Martinez Detention Facility.
