**Recovered Stolen Vehicle:** On May 14, 2019, at approximately 9:53 am, an Officer was checking on a white Ford F250 pick-up truck, parked on upper Emerald near Turquoise, a neighbor had complained about. The vehicle was reported stolen out of Richmond on April 27, 2019. A male drove up, and it was determined he was the owner of the stolen vehicle. The owner had located his vehicle in Richmond, and brought it back to his residence before removing it from the Stolen Vehicle System.

**Driving Under the Influence/Reckless Driving:** On May 14, 2019, at approximately 4:33 pm, an Officer attempted to stop a red, 2002, Kia Optima, on San Pablo Avenue passing Hercules Avenue. The vehicle drove onto the shoulder of the road and sped away. The vehicle turned east onto Pinole Valley Road, and abruptly yielded on the 800 block of Pinole Valley Road. The 27 year old male driver, of Oakland, and the 26 year old female passenger of Vallejo, were both detained. The driver displayed the objective symptoms of intoxication, and the Preliminary Alcohol Screening Device indicated he was over the presumptive limit for the purposes of driving. The driver was arrested and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility. The passenger was released from the scene with the vehicle.
