Found Property: On May 9, 2019 at 8:15 a.m. An Officer was dispatched to the area of Sycamore Ave. at Turquoise Dr. for a report of a citizen who found a spent shell casing. The reporting party was working on an electrical box when he found the shell casing. The Officer collected the item and placed it into Evidence.

Property Turned for Destruction: On May 9, 2019 at 11:20 a.m. An Officer was dispatched to a lobby detail regarding a citizen who wanted to turn in three swords for destruction. All three items were placed into evidence for later destruction.

Theft by False Pretenses: On May 9, 2019 at 11:58 a.m. An Officer was dispatched to the 200 block of Florence Ct. to take a fraud report. The reporting party said he responded to an online pop-up add on his laptop telling him he had a virus. He called a phone number, in the add, to “fix” his computer. He spoke to a male and allowed the suspect to remotely access his computer. The suspect fraudulently used his credit cards numbers to make purchases totaling \$3,000.

Auto Burglary: On May 9, 2019 at 3:09 p.m. An Officer was dispatched to a lobby detail to take an auto burglary report. The Hercules resident said an unknown suspect burglarized her vehicle while it was parked in the Lucky parking lot. The incident occurred, on April 7, 2019. The unknown suspect shattered the right front passenger window on her Gray '14 Mercedes E350 and stole her purse.

Firearm Turned in for Destruction: On May 9, 2019 at 4:23 p.m. An Officer was dispatched to a lobby detail regarding a citizen who wanted to turn in a firearm for destruction. The reporting party was cleaning out his deceased Father's house and located a Revolver and 3 boxes of ammunition. All items were placed into evidence for destruction.

Warrant Arrest On May 10th 2019 at approximately 3:25AM a HPD Officer conducted a pedestrian stop in the 800 block of Willow Ave. The 38 year old male subject, of Crockett, was taken into custody on two non-citable warrants. One was held by Alameda County SO and the other by San Francisco PD. He was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Stolen Vehicle On May 10th 2019 at approximately 4:46AM a HPD Officer was dispatched to a residence in the 200 block of Overlook Terrace for a stolen vehicle report. An unknown suspect(s) stole the victim's gold 1997 Toyota Camry sometime after 7:30PM the previous night.

Felony Probation Violation/Prowling: On May 10, 2019 at 5:02 p.m. An Officer was dispatched to 100 block of Watermark Terrace for a suspicious circumstance. The reporting party said his side fence broken into, but no entry was made into his home. The surveillance video showed an African American male in the victim's backyard at approximately 10:30 a.m. Officers recognized the 26 year old male, as a local Transient. Officers had contacted the subject, earlier, when they were called to the 100 block of Paradise Dr. The subject was looking through the apartment windows. The subject was located and detained. The Apartments Management wanted the subject warned for Trespassing. The subject was warned and released. The reporting party, from Watermark Terrace, wanted to press charges against the subject for prowling and signed a complainant's arrest form. The subject was not located for the second event. The case will be forwarded to the District Attorney

Outside Assist On May 11th 2019 at approximately 2:00AM HPD units were advised of a motorcycle down somewhere on Highway 4 near Hercules. Officers responded to conduct a welfare check and located a solo vehicle collision on westbound 4 west of Carbon Way. The vehicle had rolled over into the ditch and trapped the driver. The collision also caused a grass fire that began to spread. Officers stayed on scene until RHFD and CHP units arrived.

Prisoner Transport: On May 11, 2019 at 8:35 a.m. A Reserve Officer responded to Santa Clara County Jail in San Jose to pick-up a 44 year old male, of San Jose. The subject was being held on our outstanding Felony No Bail Warrant related to a Hercules case. The Warrant was issued on April 16, 2019. The subject was transported to the Martine Detention Facility,

Outside Assist On May 11th 2019 at approximately 10:35PM The Contra Costa County Sheriff's Department requested Code 3 cover, from Hercules PD, to assist with a shooting in the 1000 block of Mariposa St. Hercules Officers arrived assisted with crowd control and evidence location.

Vehicle Tampering X2: On May 12, 2019, at approximately 8:57 am, HPD Officers were dispatched to the area of the 200 block of Starling for the report of two subjects trying to break into cars. The Reporting Party was still following the subjects, and they were running south on Pheasant from Starling. An Officer arrived, and observed the two subjects running on Pheasant. Officer located, and detained, the 14 and 15 year old males. Two different victims, one from Sparrow Drive, and one from Starling Way, positively identified both subjects as the subjects who were trying to break into their cars. The two juveniles were arrested and transported to Hercules PD. They were later released to their parents after being given a citation.

Hit and Run Collision: On May 12, 2019, at approximately 4:10 pm, HPD Officers were dispatched to a collision, of a motorcycle into a fence, in the 3200 block of South Front Street. Officers were advised the motorcycle, and driver, left the scene. Witnesses said the motorcycle was associated with a house in the 2000 block of Central Street. The residents allowed the Officers to check the garage, and no motorcycles were located.

Online Vandalism (BobCop): On May 12, 2019, at approximately 5:12 pm, a citizen submitted an online report for vandalism. Today the home owner noticed a side window was broken. It appeared someone threw a rock through the window.

Warrant Arrest: On May 13, 2019, at 6:20 a.m., an officer checked on a suspicious vehicle, occupied by three subjects, at 3600 San Pablo Avenue. A 46 year old male, of Hayward, was standing outside a black 2016 Hyundai, occupied by two other citizens. During the contact, the officer discovered the subject had an outstanding probation violation warrant for. He was arrested and transported to Martinez Detention Facility for the warrant.
