**Warrant Cite:** On July 3, 2019 at 11:04am, an officer conducted a traffic stop on a white 2017 Chrysler minivan for no front plate. The 29 year old male driver had a warrant out of Marin County and was cited and released at the scene.

**Outside Assist:** On July 3, 2019 at 4:08pm, HPD units were dispatched to the area of the 1600 block of Partridge Way. Officers made contact a 32 year old female and a 20 year old male. They got into an argument in Vallejo. The female stated the male punched her on her left hip. The male left for the day and a report was taken and forwarded to Vallejo PD.

**Warrant Arrest:** On July 3, 2019 at 4:44pm, HPD units responded to the 600 block of Silver Maple for an unwanted subject. Officers contacted a 21 year old male who had a No Bail warrant out of Richmond PD. He was arrested and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

**Fraud:** On July 3, 2019 at 4:36pm, an officer took a lobby detail regarding a fraud case. The 64 year old female was tricked into paying \$1,500 to someone posing as an Apple Support Representative. She went to Best Buy in Pinole and purchased Apple Gift Cards while the suspect stayed on line with her and walked her through how she needed to pay.

**Violation of Domestic Violence Restraining Order:** On July 3, 2019 at about 6:43pm, an Officer responded to HPD lobby for a report of a restraining order violation. The victim said her ex-husband is constantly harassing her by texting and calling her, in violation of the restraining order.

**Found Property** On July 3<sup>rd</sup> 2019 at approximately 9:21PM a HPD Officer was dispatched to the area of Bristol and Windsor for two found backpacks. The Officer located a piece of mail that belonged to a subject out of Buena Park. Contact was made, via telephone, and he stated the backpacks were taken during an auto burglary in Oakland. The backpacks were booked in to property for Safe Keeping.

**Warrant Arrest** On July 3<sup>rd</sup> 2019 at approximately 10:46PM a HPD Officer checked on a two suspicious vehicles in the 3900 block of San Pablo Ave. A subject, associated with a silver

2008 Chrysler Sebring, was identified as a 33 year old male of Richmond. He had a non-citable traffic warrant, held by San Pablo PD. He was arrested and transported to the Martine Detention Facility.

**Auto Burglary:** On July 4, 2019, at 10:13am, an officer was dispatched to the 2000 block of Railroad Ave. for an auto burglary report. The Fairbanks, Arkansas resident stated he parked and locked his white 2008 Toyota Tundra on Bayfront Ave. at Railroad Ave at 4:00pm on July 1, 2019. When he returned to his vehicle at 5:00pm, the same day, he noticed his window was shattered and a back pack was missing.

**Found Property:** On July 4, 2019 at 3:22 pm, an officer was dispatched to 1200 block of Earnest St. for a found property report. The reporting party's children found identification cards in the creek near their home on Avocet and Sanderling belonging to two adult females. One out of Santa Rosa, and the other out of Marin City. One victim's white 2015 Ford Mustang was parked, and unlocked, in the 1100 block of Promenade on July 1 2019, at 6:00pm. When they returned to the vehicle today at 3:00pm, they discovered their wallets were missing.

**Runaway Juvenile:** On July 4<sup>th</sup> 2019 at approximately 9:55PM a HPD Officer was dispatched to a residence in the 100 block of Jacaranda Ct for a runaway 16 year old female. The subject was expected home around 7:00pm but had not returned. The subject was entered into the missing and Unidentified Persons System.

**Warrant Arrest:** On July 4<sup>th</sup> 2019 at approximately 10:47PM a HPD Officer checked on a suspicious vehicle in the 3900 block of San Pablo Ave. One of the occupants an adult female, was determined to have two citable warrants held by San Jose PD. She was cite/released at the scene.

**Party:** On July 4<sup>th</sup> 2019 at approximately 11:21PM HPD units were dispatch to the area of Sparrow Way and Tanager Way for a party in the area. Officers located a large party at a house in the 400 block of Sparrow Way. It appeared the house was full and more people were showing up. Officers stayed on scene and provided crowd and traffic control until the party began to disperse. Officers again returned at approximately 2:30AM for a noise complaint. The number of party goers had decreased significantly. At its peak an estimated 150 people in or around the area for the party.

**Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol::** On July 5<sup>th</sup> 2019 at approximately 1:35AM a HPD Officer conducted a traffic enforcement stop, on a silver 2011 Jaguar XF, in the 1600 block of Sycamore Ave. The 29 year old driver, of Richmond, displayed the objective symptoms of being under the influence of alcohol. The Standard Field Sobriety Test was conducted. The Preliminary Alcohol Screening device indicated he was over the presumptive limit for the purposes of driving. He was placed under arrest The subject refused to provide a voluntary blood sample and a warrant was obtained. The subject was transported to the Martine Detention Facility.

**Warrant Arrest:** On July 5<sup>th</sup> 2019 at approximately 2:13AM HPD Officers were dispatched to a disturbance in the 100 block of Glenwood. Officers located approximately 6 subjects involved in a physical fight. One of the subjects, a 22 year old male of Hercules, was taken in custody for a warrant out of Kern County. He was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

**Dog Bite:** On July 5<sup>th</sup> 2019 at 1:30 pm, Officers were dispatched to the area of the 100 block of S. Wildwood for a report of a female bitten by a dog. A 35 year old female was walking her small dog, on a leash, when a loose pit bull attacked her dog. She tried separate the dogs

and the pitbull bit her on the right hand. The female was transported, by ambulance, to a hospital. Animal Control quarantined the dog. The owner of the pitbull stated her dog snuck out while she was cleaning the garage.

**Warrant Arrest:** On July 7, 2019 at 9:30 a.m. Hercules Officers went to the 100 block of Robin Ct. to serve an outstanding Misdemeanor warrant. Officers contacted the 64 year old male as he exited the front door and took him into custody. The Warrant was issued on July 3, 2019. He was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

**Unlicensed Driver & Warrant Arrest:** On July 7, 2019 at 12:16 p.m. an Officer did a traffic enforcement stop on a White '99 VW for a registration violation. The 20 year old female driver did not have a driver's license. The 20 year old male passenger had an outstanding Misdemeanor cite releasable Warrant out of Trinity County Sheriff's Department. The Warrant was issued on June 18, 2018. The male was cited and released. The female was also cited and released, for not having a driver's license.

**Warrant Arrest:** On July 7, 2019, at 7:10 p.m., an officer stopped 39 year old male, while driving a dark gray 2012 Chrysler Town & Country van, for a vehicle code violation. The van belonged to the 41 year male old passenger. The passenger had an outstanding "No cite" warrant out of Napa County. He was placed under arrest and transported to Martinez Detention Facility.

**Warrant Arrest:** On June 7, 2019, at 7:57 p.m., an employee from Rite Aid, 1560 Sycamore Avenue, called to report a female was inside the store concealing items in her purse. Officers contacted a 44 year old female, of Richmond, who was still inside the store. The subject had already returned the items before being contacted by officers. She was found to have an outstanding "No cite" \$70,000 warrant for failure to comply with a court order regarding a theft case out of El Cerrito. She was transported to Martinez Detention Facility.
