Strong Arm Robbery: On July 30, 2019, at approximately 11:36 am, HPD Officers were dispatched, to the area of the 3200 block of South Front Street, for the report of a strong arm robbery which just occurred. The 70 year old female victim was walking up to a house when an adult male walked up behind her and pulled her purse from her arm. The victim fell to the ground, and the suspect got into the passenger seat of an older model car driven away by another suspect. The victim did not sustain any injuries.

Lost Property: On July 30, 2019, at approximately 1:55 pm, an Officer handled a lobby detail regarding lost check books. Sometime between July 6, 2019, and today, a resident from the 200 block of Lilac Circle, lost check books for her bank accounts. The Checkbooks were from Bank of America, and First Nor Cal Credit Union. The checks have all been cancelled.

Domestic Battery: On July 30, 2019, at approximately 4:24 pm, HPD Officers were dispatched to Ben Lomond for a domestic altercation. Officers contacted a 39 year old male and a 38 year old female. The male stopped by to try to work out a custody agreement over their minor child. An argument ensued and the male tried to leave. The female blocked the door way and the male brushed up against her as he was leaving. The female fell down, and had slight pinkish color mark on her right bicep area. A case was taken for domestic violence. The male left the area and went home.

Corporal injury to a spouse (Cold Report): On July 30, 2019 at approximately 9:47pm, Officers responded to the 100 block of Glenwood for a report of a verbal argument. Officers contacted a 32 year old female, and her 69 year old husband, who were engaged in an argument. Both parties stated that nothing physical had occurred between them and the husband left the residence. Once the husband left the female told Officers about an altercation that occurred earlier in the day. The female said her husband attempted to grab her in a choke hold and then pushed her to the ground. She hit her head on the wall causing bruising and swelling to her head, neck and face. The female did not want to press charges nor did she want a want and Emergency Protective Order. A case was taken for documentation.

Outside Assist: On July 31, 2019 at approximately 12:05am, Officers were contacted by Daly City PD. Daly City requested Officers check an address, in the 100 block of Goldenrod, for a suspect in a domestic violence case in their City. Officers located the 39 year old male suspect, in the front yard of the residence. He was taken into custody and later picked by Daly City PD.
