Warrant Arrest: On July 31, 2019, at 9:16AM, an Officer checked on an occupied vehicle in the Rite Aid parking lot. A 31 year old female was contacted and found to have a citable, misdemeanor warrant. She was given a new court date and cite/released from the scene.

Auto Burglary: On July 31, 2019, at 9:41AM, an Officer was dispatched to 3600 Sn Pablo Avenue for an auto burglary report. The reporting party stated he went inside Starbucks around 9:00AM. Hit and Run On July 31st 2019 at approximately 6:41PM a HPD Officer was dispatched to the area of Sycamore Ave and San Pablo Ave for, a non-injury, hit and run collision. The reporting party, of San Francisco, stated an unknown subject, in a green pickup, collided with the rear bumper of her silver Lexus and fled the scene. The truck was last seen on San Pablo Ave toward Rodeo.

Warrant Arrest /Possession of a Controlled Substance: On August 1st 2019 at approximately 12:38AM a HPD Officer checked on a suspicious vehicle parked in the 1100 block of South Shelter Bay. One of the occupants, a 39 year old male of Richmond, was taken into custody on a non-citable warrant. When the subject was removed from the vehicle the Officer located a plastic baggie containing a substance suspected to be a narcotic. The subject was issued a Citation for the Possession of a Controlled Substance. He was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility on the warrant.

Possession of A Controlled Substance and Paraphernalia: A probable cause search of the vehicle was conducted and more suspected narcotics, and a glass pipe, were located hidden in the fuse box near the driver's seat. The 48 year old male, registered owner, of Vallejo was seated in the driver's seat. He was taken into custody and cite/released at the scene.
