Lost Property: On August 8, 2019, at 12:08PM, an Officer was dispatched to the Hercules PD lobby for a lost property report. The reporting party stated she believed she lost her Ford car key while attending National Night Out and movie night on August 6, 2019, between 8:00PM and 11:00PM in Refugio Valley Park.

Warrant Arrest: On August 8, 2019, at 3:23PM, an Officer conducted a traffic stop on a 1997 Chevy. The 49 year old male driver, of Martinez, was found to have a no bail warrant for failure to appear in court. The subject was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Auto Burglary: On August 8th 2019 at approximately 7:12PM HPD Officers were dispatched to the 1200 block of Promenade St for an auto burglary that just occurred. Three African American male adults were seen breaking to a Ford Mustang and running toward the Olympian Hills area. Officers conducted an area check but were unable to locate the suspects. A 2005 Ford Mustang was located with a broken out window. The victim stated the loss was a backpack.

Felon in Possession of a Concealed/Loaded Firearm/Ammo/Controlled Substance: On August 8th 2019 at approximately 8:30PM a HPD Officer conducted a traffic stop, on a white 1990 Acura Legend. During the contact, the Officer located a loaded semi-automatic pistol under the driver's seat. A search revealed a substance, suspected to be a narcotic; another unloaded semi-automatic pistol; two high capacity magazines; and a large amount of ammunition. The 39 year old male driver, of Rodeo, and a 31 year old female passenger, of Rodeo, were detained. The female was released the scene. The male was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Theft: On August 8th 2019 at approximately 10:30PM HPD Officers were dispatched to a theft that just occurred from Lucky's Supermarket. A male adult was seen getting into a black sedan. An Officer located and stopped the vehicle. The 59 year old male, of Stockton, admitted to stealing alcohol from Lucky's. A search of the vehicle yielded 30 bottles of suspected stolen alcohol. Lucky's did not desire prosecution and only wanted their item back. The bottles were taken for safe keeping and a track flyer was sent out to surrounding agencies. The subject was released pending further investigation.

Warrant Arrest: On August 9th 2019 at approximately 2:05AM a HPD Officer conducted a traffic stop on a gray 2004 Mazda. A 44yar old male passenger, of Crockett, was taken into custody on three non-citable warrants. The 48 year old female driver, of Crocket, was also taken into custody on three non-citable theft warrants, Both subjects were transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Grand Theft: On August 9, 2019, at 6:49AM, an Officer was dispatched to 1000 Crepe Myrtle for a theft report. The reporting party stated, sometime between 10:00PM last night

and 5:55AM this morning, an unknown suspect stole the catalytic converter from her 2005 Toyota Prius which was parked on the street in front of the residence.

Petty Theft: On August 9, 2019, at 9:18AM, an Officer was dispatched to the 900 block of Dover Way for a theft of a license plate report. The reporting party said someone stole his rear license plate, from his 2016 Mercedes, sometime between 8:30PM last night and 6:30AM this morning. The vehicle was parked in a parking stall near his residence.

Court Order Violation: On August 9, 2019, at 10:30AM, an Officer responded to Ohlone Elementary School for a court order violation. The reporting party stated the father of her two children took their children, out of their current school and enrolled them at another school in Martinez, in violation of a court order.

Possession of Burglary Tools/Probation Violation: On August 9, 2019, at 9:59M, an officer spotted an occupied suspicious Gold Infiniti, idling in the parking lot, of the Franklin Canyon Golf Course. The vehicle left the parking lot immediately and the license plates were obstructed. The officer conducted a traffic stop. The front seat passenger displayed nervous behavior. The 24 year old female, front seat, passenger was found to be on searchable probation out of Alameda County. A search revealed a window punch, brand new gloves, and a small flashlight, in the area of the vehicle where the female was sitting. No Auto Burglaries were located in the area. The 21 year old male driver, and the 22 year old rear passenger were released with the vehicle. The female was transported to Martinez Detention Facility for the burglary tools and a probation violation.

Found Property: On August 9, 2019, at 1:14PM, an Officer was dispatched to the 200 block of Linus Pauling for a found property report. A Bio-Rad employee found a backpack in the middle of the street in the 6000 block of James Watson Drive sometime overnight
