Prisoner Pick-Up: On August 19, 2019, an Officer responded to the Sacramento County Sheriff's Office in Elk Grove to pick up 49 year old Robert Harden who was being held on a Hercules warrant for possession of a controlled substance, drug paraphernalia, and driving with a suspended driver's license. Harden was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Identity Theft: On August 19, 2019, at about 5:37 pm, an Officer responded to the Hercules Police Department lobby regarding an identity theft. The victim received a letter from Kohl's Department store indicating they needed more information for a credit card he unknowingly attempted to open. The victim said he did not attempt to open any credit cards. He checked his ring camera at home and learned a package was attempted to be delivered to his home a couple of days ago. He contacted the Fed Ex shipping center and they told him someone came in and picked up a package. The victim stated he did not order anything to be shipped to his home.

Mental Health Evaluation: On August 19, 2019, at 8:28 pm, a frantic citizen from a residence in the 1900 block of Pheasant Drive called to report people were trying to enter her home. Officers arrived on scene and discovered her 30yr old son was displaying symptoms of schizophrenia and she feared for her safety. The subject was transported to the Contra Costa Regional Medical Center for a mental health evaluation.

Warrant Arrest: On August 19, 2019, at about 10:19 pm, an Officer initiated a traffic enforcement stop on a 2006 Chrysler 300 at 3600 San Pablo Avenue. The front seat passenger, 50 year old Jose Espinoza Garcia of Clearlake was found to have an outstanding \$5,000 misdemeanor warrant out of Vallejo for failing to appear on a possession of a controlled substance case. He was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Possession of a Controlled Substance: During the above traffic stop, an Officer located drug paraphernalia and a useable amount of suspected methamphetamine on Jose's person. He was booked for possession of a controlled substance and drug paraphernalia.
