Death Investigation: On August 20, 2019, at about 9:17 am, Officers were dispatched to the Franklin Canyon Golf Course for a person not breathing with CPR in progress. Officers arrived and Rodeo Hercules fire and paramedics were on scene performing CPR on a 72 year old male subject. Shortly after officers arrived the subject was pronounced deceased by paramedics. There were no signs of foul play and the coroner released the body to family.

Ammunition turned in for Destruction: On August 20, 2019, at about 11:00 am, a citizen came to the Hercules Police Department lobby and turned in old ammunition for destruction.

Mental Health Evaluation: On August 20, 2019, at about 4:36 pm, Officers were dispatched to a residence in the 200 block Meadowlark for a dispute between roommates. One of the roommates reportedly had a knife. One of the involved parties was contacted and said the knife was never used to threaten anyone. The other involved party was contacted and said no one likes him and he wanted to kill himself. The subject was determined to be a danger to himself, and transported by ambulance to the Contra Costa County Regional Medical Center by ambulance for a mental health evaluation.

Stolen Vehicle: On August 20, 2019, at about 5:12 pm, an Officer was dispatched to a residence in the 100 block of Heather for a reported stolen vehicle. The victim said sometime between August 16, 2019, and the time of call an unknown suspect stole a green, 1997, Lexus SC400, CA license plate number 6HAA454 from the driveway of the residence. The Lexus was entered into a stolen vehicle system.

Vehicle Collision: On August 20, 2019 at about 7:43 pm, Officers were dispatched to the 100 block of South Wildwood for a solo vehicle collision into a fence. Upon arrival, Officers located a silver 2015 Kia Sol with front end damage. The driver was a 52 year old female from Hercules. She said she mistook the gas for the break and drove into the rear fence of a residence. A case was taken for the damaged property.

Stolen Vehicle: On August 21, 2019, an Officer was dispatched to a report of a stolen vehicle from a residence in the 1600 block of Partridge Dr. The victim stated that sometime between August 16, and August 20, 2019, an unknown suspect stole his black 2015 Audi A4 (CA license plate 7HZM572) from his driveway. All the keys are accounted for and no one else had permission to be driving the vehicle. The vehicle was entered into the Stolen Vehicle System.

Warrant Arrest: On August 21, 2019 at about 1:23 am, an Officer initiated a traffic enforcement stop on a blue Honda Accord in the area of San Pablo Ave at Victoria Crescent East. The driver of the vehicle was identified as 41 year old Morris Powell out of Vallejo and was determined to have a felony no bail parole warrant issued by CDC. Powell is also currently on parole for burglary. Powell was taken into custody without incident and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Domestic Violence / Resist or Delay a Peace Officer: On August 21, 2019, at about 3:50 am, Officers were dispatched to a residence in the 100 block of Crystal Circle for a report of a domestic disturbance. The caller stated her husband had back handed her across the face while she was sleeping. On arrival Officers located the husband in the front entry way of the residence. He refused commands to come out of his residence and then resisted while being detained. He was subsequently placed under arrest for domestic battery and resisting arrest and later transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.
