**Auto Burglary:** On September 30, 2019, at approximately 8:37 am, an Officer was dispatched to Ohlone Community Center located at 201 Turquoise Drive for an auto burglary. Sometime between 6:20 am, and 6:35 am, an unknown suspect broke the passenger side rear window of a 2012 Toyota. The suspect opened the trunk to the vehicle with the trunk release from inside the vehicle, and then took two pairs of Nike Jordan shoes from the trunk of the vehicle.

**Prisoner Pick-up:** On September 30, 2019, a Parking Enforcement Officer went to Santa Rita Jail to pick up a 34 year old male for an outstanding Hercules Misdemeanor Warrant. The subject was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility and booked for the warrant.

**Theft from Unlocked Car:** On September 30, 2019, at approximately 2:28 pm, an Officer handled a lobby detail regarding a theft from an unlocked vehicle. On September 28, 2019, at approximately 12:00 pm, an unknown suspect entered an unlocked Ford Fusion parked in the parking lot of the senior housing located at 1550 Sycamore and stole a wallet, a driver's license, and multiple credit cards.

**Auto Burglary:** On September 30, 2019, at approximately 4:11 pm, an Officer was dispatched to Rite Aid located at 1560 Sycamore Avenue for an auto burglary. Sometime between 2:00 pm, and 4:00 pm, an unknown suspect broke the passenger rear window of a 2002 Honda CRV and stole a bag containing keys, a cell phone, and a pair of shoes.

**Traffic Collision (Vehicle vs Ped):** On September 30, 2019 at approximately 7:41 pm, HPD Officers were dispatched to the intersection of Sycamore Avenue / San Pablo Avenue regarding a vehicle vs. pedestrian collision. The 34 year old pedestrian, of Hercules, was attempting to cross the intersection westbound Sycamore Avenue against a red light. He collided with the passenger side of a 2012 Honda Accord. The subject suffered minor injuries as a result of the collision and denied being transported to the hospital.

**Warrant Arrest:** On October 1, 2019 at approximately 1:21 am, an Officer contacted a 40 year old male, of Richmond. A records check revealed he had an outstanding \$5,000 warrant with a no-cite clause. The subject was arrested and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.
