Battery/Brandishing a weapon other than a firearm/Child Endangerment: On September 25, 2019 at approximately 2:36pm, HPD officers were dispatch to a fight in progress in the parking lot of 844 Willow Avenue between two females. Dispatch advised one subject had a tire iron. On arrival the parties were already separated and both declined medical assistance. 33 and 38 year old females got into a fight because of an altercation that occurred between their teenage daughters at their school. One female had some abrasion and slight bruising to her arms and chest and the other had slight redness on her body. During the fight, one of the teenage daughters attempted to physically intervene, The 38 year old supposedly brandished a tire iron in self-defense. Both parties did not want prosecution. A case was taken to be for documentation.

Voluntary Missing Adult: On September 25, 2019 at approximately 5:19pm, an officer took a phone report for a voluntary missing person. The reporting party said her 23 year old granddaughter was missing. The subject was last seen on September 22, 2019 at the Contra Costa Regional Medical Center. She left without being discharged. The reporting party last spoke to the subject, via phone, on September 22, 2019 at approximately 6:00pm. The subject stated she was at an unknown location in Hercules. The subject was entered into the Missing and Unidentified Person System.

Petty Theft On September 25th 2019 at approximately 9:03PM a HPD Officer was dispatched to the 3600 block of San Pablo Ave for a stolen cell phone. The reporting party stated an unknown person stole her iphone sometime after 8:00AM while she was working.
