Residential Burglary – Backyard Shed: On October 3, 2019 at 9:53 a.m. An Officer was dispatched to the 200 block of Sparrow Dr. to take a report for a burglary to a backyard shed. The victim stated an unknown suspect forced entry into her backyard shed sometime between 11:00 p.m. last night and 8:00 a.m. this morning. The unknown suspect stole two old flat screen T.V.'s, two old HP laptop computers, and misc. children's toys.

Auto Burglary/Identity Theft: On October 3, 2019 12:45 p.m. An Officer was dispatched to a lobby detail to take a late reported (**January 2019**) auto burglary. The reporting party said an unknown suspect shattered the right rear passenger window on his '10 Infiniti FX 35, while it was parked on Sorrento Ct. The suspects stole his suitcase that contained his wallet and laptop computer. The reporting party has been contacted by both Martinez PD and Novato PD who had suspects, in-custody, in possession of his stolen property (credit cards). An unknown suspect also fraudulently opened a Sprint cell phone account using the victim's name and personal identifying information.

Grand Theft: On October 4, 2019 at approximately 5:25 am, an Officer was dispatched to the 900 block of Dover for the report of a theft of four (4) wheels from a 2019 Toyota Camry. The victim stated she parked her vehicle, in a stall, at the corner of Dover and Cambridge at approximately 11:00 pm the previous night. When she returned to her vehicle she noticed her vehicle wheels (valued at \$1200) had been stolen.

Vandalism: On October 4, 2019 at 11:11 a.m. An Officer was dispatched to the Aventine Apartments, 1375 Sycamore Ave. he reporting party noticed scratches all the way around her VW Tiguan. The vehicle was parked in the reporting party's assigned parking stall in the underground parking garage.

Theft of a license plate: On October 4, 2019 at approximately 6:58 pm, an Officer was dispatched to the Lucky store (1590 Sycamore Avenue) regarding a theft of a license plate. The reporting party stated an unknown suspect stole the rear license plate of his vehicle (2007 Chevy Silverado). The theft occurred sometime between 7:45 am and the time of call. The victim doesn't know where the theft took place. The plate number was entered into SVS as lost/stolen.

Vehicle Tampering: On October 5, 2019 at 11:15 a.m. An Officer was dispatched to the 100 block of Secret Cove to take a vehicle tampering report. The reporting party stated an unknown suspect drilled a hole in the gas tank of his White '06 Ford F150 and stole a full tank of gas (\$78.00 value). The incident occurred sometime between 8:00 p.m. on October 3, 2019 and 8:30 a.m. on October 4, 2019,

Recovered stolen license plate: On October 5, 2019 at 2:12 p.m. An Officer was dispatched to a lobby detail. The reporting party said she recently reported her vehicle's license plates stolen to BART PD. BART PD found another license plate attached to the rear of her '16 Mazda CX-5. The victim was given this license plate. The license plate returned as being a stolen license plate taken from a Blue '05 Infiniti G35 on September 20, 2019 (reported to CHP-Woodland). The Officer took possession of the recovered stolen license plate and had Dispatch remove it from the Stolen Vehicle System

Shoplifting: On October 5, 2019 at 2:21 p.m. An Officer was dispatched to the AT&T Store, 1581 Sycamore Ave. Suite 2, to take a report for a theft of headphones that occurred approximately 10-15 minutes ago. The suspect was described as an Asian male adult; 25-30; 507-508; 160-190 lbs; wearing a Black baseball hat, Red T-Shirt, Black Jeans, and Red Sneakers. . The unknown suspect entered the store and took a box containing Black Beats Studio 3 Wireless headphones (\$379.54) from a store display shelf. An employee confronted the suspect and asked him if he needed help. The suspect then told the employee he wanted to exchange the headphones for a Red colored Beats headphones. The employee went to the back of the store to check to see if they had that color and the suspect walked out with the box of headphones. The employee then realized the suspect had stolen the headphones he was holding and followed him outside. The employee saw the suspect get into a White 4DR sedan and saw him drive away towards Big Lots.

Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol/Child Endangerment: On October 5, 2019, at 1:38 a.m., an officer stopped a 31 year old male driver, of Stockton, at 3600 San Pablo Avenue, for a moving violation. The subject displayed objective symptoms of intoxication and was given field sobriety tests. The Preliminary Alcohol Screening device indicated the subject was over the presumptive limit for the purposes of driving. He was placed under arrest. He was later cited and released to a relative. A child endangerment charge was added due to there being three minor passengers (6, 10, and 13) in the Mitsubishi (CFS was notified).

Natural Death: On October 6, 2019, at 6:32 p.m., RHFD and Hercules Police responded to the 100 block Glenwood for a report of a 92 year old female, who "Passed away. The subject had prior medical issues and had a DNR in place. The coroner released her to the family.
