Non-Injury Collision: On October 8, 2019, at approximately 10:08 am, an Officer was dispatched to the 1900 block of Lupine Road for a hit and run collision which occurred over night. The Officer contacted the owner of the damaged vehicle and was able to determine the owner of the vehicle that struck the parked vehicle. The Officer contacted the other party and a case was taken for a property damage only collision report.

Assault with a Deadly Weapon: On October 8, 2019, at approximately 1:32 pm, Richmond Kaiser contacted HPD to say a 41 year old male, from Hercules, was in the Emergency Room with head injuries from being attacked earlier in the day in Hercules. A detective went out to the hospital to interview the victim. The victim said he was somewhere, near his house on Sanderling in Hercules, and was struck in the back of the head. He had no idea who the suspect was, and could not even provide an exact location. A case was taken to document the incident.
