**Court Order Violation:** On December 16, 2019, at 12:19 pm, a School Resource Officer took a case for a court order violation. The father of a high school and middle school student has been in contact with his children in violation of a served court order.

**Auto Burglary:** On December 16, 2019, at 12:38 pm, an Officer was dispatched to the 800 block of Willow Avenue for an auto burglary. Sometime between 11:20 am and 11:40 am, an unknown suspect broke the rear driver side window of a 2009 Mini-Cooper and stole a bag containing a laptop computer and miscellaneous clothing items.

**Auto Burglary:** On December 16, 2019, at 1:00 pm, an Officer was dispatched to the 1600 block of Sycamore Avenue for an auto burglary report. Sometime between 9:30 am, and 1:00 pm, an unknown suspect broke the rear driver side window of a 2017 Subaru and stole a suitcase and backpack, containing a phone. About an hour later the suitcase and backpack (but no phone) were located to the rear of Lucky.

**Battery:** On December 16, 2019, at 4:37 pm, HPD Officers were dispatched to a family disturbance in the 200 block of Nutmeg. Officers determined a fight occurred between a father and his adult son. The father did not desire prosecution.

**Warrant Arrest 2X:** On December 16, 2019, at approximately 9:11 pm, an Officer checked on a black, Dodge Van, with no license plates, in the Home Depot Parking lot. The lone occupant was a 40 year old female. The female had two outstanding felony warrants. While dealing with the original subject, a 31 year old female, and 27 year old male, walked out of Home Depot, and approached the vehicle. The second female also had two outstanding felony warrants. The male was on searchable probation. The male was released and the two females were transported to the Martinez Detention Facility for warrants.

**Assault with Deadly Weapon:** On December 17, 2019, at approximately 6:35 am, HPD Officers were dispatched to the 1100 block of Devonwood for the report of a male with his eyes burning and having difficulty breathing. Officers made contact with a 28 year old male, in front of the residence. Officers determined the subject got into an argument with his 38 year old male friend. The subject said his friend attacked him with a small box cutter style knife. The subject sustained a minor cut on his leg. The subject sprayed the suspect with pepper spray. The suspect ran away towards Forest Run. The Officers checked all the local stores and the Forest Run area and were not able to locate the suspect.
