Auto Burglary: On December 18, 2019 at 10:42 a.m. Hercules Officers were dispatched to the parking lot of Lucky, 1590 Sycamore Ave, for a report of an auto burglary that just occurred. The suspect, who was described as wearing a black hooded sweatshirt, just shattered a window on a Gray Mercedes and stole a bag. The suspect was last seen getting into a Black SUV, possibly a Kia, which turned left onto Refugio Valley Rd. from the parking lot. An Officer located the victim vehicle, a Gray '19 Mercedes Benz GLA, with a shattered right front passenger window. The Hercules resident said unknown suspect stole her purse, a work bag, and an iPad Mini.

Expired Driver's License/Possession of a Controlled Substance/Possession of Drug Paraphernalia: On December 18, 2019 at 10:36 a.m. An Officer did a traffic stop on a Maroon '03 Cadillac CTS for a vehicle code violation. The 45 year old driver, of El Sobrante, was found to have an expired driver's license. The subject admitted to having a pipe, commonly used to smoke narcotics, in the center console box. A probable cause search was done and the Officer located the pipe as well as a small white crystallized rock substance suspected to be narcotics. The subject was cited and released for the Expired License and the narcotic violations.
