Missing Person Locate On January 2, 2020 at approximately 3:38 PM Officers were contacted by a Kern County Deputy in regards to an adult missing person. Officers responded to the 200 block of Ben Lomond. The subject was located at the residence and rendered safe, he said he was reported missing in 2017.

Possession. of a Controlled Substance/paraphernalia On January 3rd 2020 at approximately 1:04AM a HPD Officer conducted a traffic stop, on a white 2004 Ford F150, in the area of Sycamore Ave and Refugio Valley Road. During a consent search, pills, suspected to be narcotics, and paraphernalia was discovered. A 31 year old female, of Vallejo, was cite/released at the scene.

Coroner's Case: On January 03, 2020 at approximately 4:54 PM, HPD Officers were dispatched to The 100 block of Pearce for a caller stating her husband was deceased. Officers arrived, with Station 76. Paramedics pronounced the 75 year old male deceased at 5:03 PM. The subject was under a doctor's care for several medical issues. The Coroner's Office was contacted and the body was released to the family.

Hit and Run: On January 3rd 2020 at approximately 9:15PM a HPD Officer was dispatched to the 800 block of Willow Ave for a non-injury hit and run collision. The reporting party stated a black BMW struck her vehicle then fled the scene.

Possession. of controlled substance/paraphernalia: On January 3rd 2020 at approximately 11:21PM a HPD Officer contacted a 51 year old male, in the area of Refugio Valley Road and Pheasant Dr. A search of the subject revealed a glass pipe and suspected narcotics. He was cite/released at the scene.

Firearms Safekeeping: On January 04, 2020 at 9:52 AM an adult arrived at the station to turn in four firearm lower receivers', and one .rife. This was due to a restraining order issued by Contra Costa County. The lower receivers' and the rifle were booked into Hercules PD Evidence for safekeeping.

Warrant Arrest: On January 4, 2020 at approximately 2:29 PM Officer's contacted an adult male, in the 1500 block of Partridge Dr. The subject was found to have a Warrant, out of Berkeley PD, for Robbery. The subject was arrested and later picked up by Berkeley PD Officers.

Officers located the subject seated inside a vehicle. During the contact, Officers were able to see, in plain view, multiple prescription medication bottles. The subject also appeared to be attempting to conceal something underneath the seat. Officers conducted a probable cause search and located suspected narcotics. The 27 year old male, of Richmond, was taken into custody. He was later cite/released at the scene...

Coroner's case: On January 5, 2020 at approximately 8:39pm, Officers responded to the 100 block of Farragut St. for a report of a 77 year old male who was unresponsive and not breathing. Officers, and RHFD Engine #76. Paramedics, performed life saving measures, but the subject was pronounced deceased. The subject was under a doctor's care for several medical issues The Contra Costa County Coroner's Office was contacted and released the body to the family.
