Warrant Arrest: On January 30, 2020 at 10:26 a.m. an Officer did a traffic stop on a White '02 Chevy Camaro for a registration violation. The driver was a 27 year old male, of Pittsburg. The 27 year old female front passenger, of Oakland, had two outstanding cite releasable Warrants out of San Jose P.D. Both Warrants were issued on August 19, 2019. The subject was arrested and was cited and released at the scene.

Non-Injury Vehicle Collision: On January 31, 2020 at 7:16 a.m. An Officer was dispatched to the intersection of San Pablo Ave. at John Muir Parkway for a report of a vehicle collision involving a Gold '01 Toyota Rav-4 and a Beige '96 Ford Explorer. The driver of the Explorer and vehicle were gone. The Officer located a phone number for the driver of the Explorer and the driver and vehicle returned. The Explorer was driving E/B John Muir Parkway when the driver of the Rav-4 was making a left turn from Tioga Loop onto E/B John Muir Parkway. The Rav-4 then collide into the left rear of the Explorer.

Vandalism: On January 31, 2020 at 1:11 p.m. A School Resource Officer (SRO) was notified by Hercules Middle School employee of a vandalism. The employee told the SRO an unidentified student found graffiti in the girl's bathroom on the Middle School Campus.

Warrant Arrest: On January 31st, at approximately 10:51 pm, an officer conducted a traffic stop of a blue Jeep. The 42 year old male driver, of Oakland, was found to have a non-citable warrant. The subject was arrested and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Warrant Arrest X3/ Possession of concealed firearm by felon: On February 1st, at approximately 1:31 am, an officer conducted a traffic stop of a black 2004 BMW. The 41 year old male owner(front passenger) of the vehicle, of Vallejo, was found to have three outstanding warrants out of Solano County. The subject was placed under arrest for the warrants. During an inventory search, of BMW, the officer located a semi-automatic handgun inside of the subject's backpack. The Felon in Possession of a Firearm charge was added and the subject was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Driving under the influence: On February 1st, 2020 at approximately 4:45am, an officer was in the area of W/8 1-80 on-ramp from Willow Avenue when he observed a 2013 Hyundai failing to maintain a lane and speeding (DUI indicators). The officer conducted a stop on the vehicle in the 1500 block of Pinole Valley Road. The 23 year old male driver, of San Francisco, displayed the objective signs of intoxication. The subject was given the Standard Field Sobriety Test and the Preliminary Alcohol Screen device indicated the subject was over the presumptive limit for driving. He was arrested and later cite/released to a responsible party.

Death: On February 1, 2020, at approximately 1:27 pm, HPD Officers were dispatched to the 400 block of Turquoise Drive for a person not breathing. Officers arrived along with RHFD. The 80 year old citizen was pronounced deceased at 1:45 pm. There was a Do Not Resuscitate order on file.

Court Order Violation: On February 1, 2020, at 5:18 pm, HPD Officers were dispatched to Hill Court for a restraining order violation. The victim stated a 77 year old male arrived at the residence to retrieve some belongings. The served order states that the subject needs to stay 100 yards from the residence and its occupants. The subject was gone upon Officers' arrival.

Driving Under the Influence: On February 2, 2020 at approximately 2:04am, an officer located a white Dodge Ram stopped at the intersection of Sycamore Ave at Lupine Rd. The 47 year old male driver, out of Vallejo, was passed out in the driver seat. The subject displayed objective signs of intoxication. The subject was given the Standard Field Sobriety Test. The Preliminary Alcohol Screening device indicated the subject was over the presumptive limit for the purposes of driving. The subject was taken into custody for DUI. He was later booked into the Martinez Detention Facility.

Possession of a Controlled Substance: On February 2, 2020 at 5:41pm, an officer contacted an adult male standing outside McDonalds. During a consent search, an officer located a substance, believed to be a narcotic, concealed in the subject's beanie. He was arrested and later cited and released.

Warrant: On February 2, 2020 at approximately 9:24pm, an Officer stopped a white 1999 Mercury in the area of WB I80 at Pinole Valley Rd. for a traffic violation. The 30 year old male passenger, out of San Pablo, had an active misdemeanor warrant out of Contra Costa County. The subject was arrested and was cited and released at the scene.
