**Unauthorized use of an access card:** On February 3, 2020 at 9:44 a.m. A Detective went to Rite Aid, 1560 Sycamore Ave, to conduct an investigation related to an Identity Theft case that originated in San Ramon. An unknown suspect unlawfully used the San Ramon victim's credit card at the Hercules Rite Aid.

**Criminal Threats/Annoying or Harassing Phone Calls:** On February 3, 2020 at 4:18 p.m. An Officer was dispatched to a lobby detail to take a report for harassing text messages. The Hercules Resident said an unknown suspect has been sending him harassing text messages threatening him and his family. The suspect is demanding the victim send him money. The Officer researched name the suspect used, and the associated phone number. The Officer determined this is a documented phone scam.

The reporting party stated her 56 year old husband left the residence on February 2, 2020 at approximately 4:30pm, and had not returned. The subject left in their grey 2006 Toyota Sienna and was last seen wearing a grey sweatshirt. He left his cell phone at the house. An All-Points Bulletin flyer, and a Be on the Look Out, were sent out to surrounding agencies. The subject was also entered into the Missing and Unidentified Persons System.
